Gym Lighting Project

The four school buildings for the Gym Lighting Replacement Project are Cooper Upper Elementary, Grant Elementary, Hayes Elementary, and Ford Skill Center. The project consists of the replacing the high bay metal halide lights fixtures with fluorescent high bay fixtures and painting of the ceilings. The replacement of the old fixtures with the new fluorescent fixtures will show an energy savings to the district. The estimated cost for the project for all four schools is \$125,000 - \$150,000.

Cooper Upper Elementary remove 28 metal halide lights and replace with 28 -2x4 6 lamp high bay fluorescent fixtures.

Ford Skill Center remove 30 metal halide lights and replace with 30- 2x4 6 lamp high bay fluorescent fixtures.

Grant Elementary remove 12 metal halide lights and replace with 20 -2x4 6 lamp high bay fluorescent fixtures.

Hayes Elementary remove 16 metal halide lights and replace with 16 2x4 6 lamp high bay fluorescent fixtures.

While in the areas we will need to paint the ceiling to optimize the light reflection for the fixtures. All lights would be controlled by occupancy sensors. All lights would be eligible (as of right now) for DTE rebates to cover a portion of the cost of the fixtures.

Cost comparison for the replacement of the bulbs:

Metal halide bulb with a 20,000 hour usage cost \$75.00/bulb. Fluorescent light tube with 36,000 hour usage cost \$1.40/bulb.

We are putting together the bid specifications to place this project out to bid.
