OVERTURE'S VIEW ON PARENT PARTNERSHIP

Overture prioritizes partnership with families through a mindset of **"inspire, not require."**

Emphasizes family-style learning and **supports parents as the primary educators** with curriculum choice, regular teacher support, and access to educational resources.

Builds **relationships over compliance**, using tools like portfolios, skills checklists, and weekly check-ins to track progress and meet state standards.

REIMBURSEMENT

- Families receive reimbursements for approved items purchased.
- Each 1st-8th Grade student has an allotment of \$1,700* for the school year.
- Each Kindergarten student has an allotment of \$750 for the school year.
- Possibilities include: curriculum, internet, activities, field trips, classes, academic tutoring, lessons for elective activities (music, art, P.E., drama, life-skills), and technology purchases (computers, printers, tablets, etc.).

EASE OF REIMBURSEMENT

Simply take a picture of your receipt from your phone or upload the image from your computer. Next, enter some basic information about the expense and click submit! Reimbursements are **processed weekly**.
