AGENDA ITEM: Annual Report of the School Health Advisory Council (SHAC)

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

 Per section 28.004 of the Texas Education Code, "The board of trustees of each school district shall establish a local school health advisory council to assist the district in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the district's health education instruction."

- Section 28.004 of the Texas Education Code additionally states, "In addition to performing other duties, the local school health advisory council shall submit to the board of trustees, at least annually, a written report."
- The Aledo ISD school health advisory council met five times during the 2021-2022 school year on October 14, November 8, January 24, March 7, and May 2.
- The Aledo ISD school health advisory council consists of 34 campus-based voting members, which include 19 parents, 11 staff, and 4 students. The membership is also comprised of 5 non-voting members which represent health care, mental health care, faith community, and Education Service Center Region 11.
