- Instructional coach: we hire a company, not a person
- Instructional coach is to teach teachers how to teach common core standards for math
- Math Coaches go thru a company (like solution tree get train and then train teachers) –
 not hiring a full time person / hire a person for interventions
- Is it sustainable is there still follow through after the coach has gone away reading is still doing what they were trained to to K-3.

Computer Lab huge need for upgrade -

Math Coach would be K-12 - not strong across the board FCS 37%/SHS 32 %

\$75,000 – go into the contingency - range to work with

14/15 for the SMARTER balance assessments (mandated by state) need computer upgrades

\$150,000.00 for science curriculum / looking at on-line options
