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



Reported Weekly Cases by Age




COVID-19 Hospitalizations: Denton County




COVID-19 Percentage Inpatient Beds: Denton County

COVID-19 Percentage of Total Inpatient Beds




Onset of Illness by Week


Symptom Onset Weekly Cases by Age Range



Pediatric Onset of Illness by Week





What's the difference between a third dose and a booster shot?

Third or additional doses are for individuals who may not have a strong enough immune response after the first two doses of the mRNA COVID-19 vaccine

- Individuals must be **28 days** past their second dose and must have received **either Pfizer or Moderna COVID-19 vaccines**
- The third dose is considered part of their vaccination series

Booster shots are for people whose immune response has been weakened over time.


- The CDC and FDA **have not authorized booster shots at this time**, but the department of Health and Human Services have announced a **plan to begin offering booster shots this fall pending ACIP approval**.
- FDA is scheduled to review booster doses on Friday, September 17th.



Student Absenteeism Rate*




*Rate calculated as number of students absent from campus divided by number of students enrolled for on-campus instruction.

Daily Student Absences




Number of New Parent or Guardian-Reported COVID-19 Cases by Day


