RECOMMENDATION: Administration recommends approval of the following proposed boundary changes effective the 2024-2025 school year. These boundary changes are necessary due to the opening of Juan Roberto Ramirez Middle School and will have an impact on the student population at George Washington Middle School.

G. Washington Middle School

The boundary for G. Washington Middle School begins at IH35 and Loop 20. East along Loop 20 to the Rio Grande River. South along the Rio Grande River to an area parallel to Del Mar Blvd. East along Del Mar Blvd to IH35. North along IH35 to the point of beginning.

R. Ramirez Middle School

The boundary for R. Ramirez Middle School begins at IH35 and Loop 20. North along IH35 to Hayter Rd. North parallel to the area of Hayter Rd to the northern UISD boundary line. West along the UISD boundary line to the Rio Grande River. South along the Rio Grande River to Loop 20. East along Loop 20 to the point of beginning.

RATIONALE: With the approval of the 2013 bond program, the District has built a new middle school in the Mines Road area to alleviate George Washington Middle School who has a current enrollment of 1,093 and has 20 portable classrooms (10 buildings) to accommodate this enrollment.

Staff met with the parents of those students affected by the proposed boundary changes on November 30th at George Washington Middle School to explain the proposed boundaries for the new campus.
