ACTION REPORT: Authorization to Purchase

ITEM: PLATO Development Learning System

Since 2003, PLATO (Programmed Logic for Automated Teaching Operations) computerized tutorial software has been used in the College's Learning Centers as an essential assessment of college readiness and progress in developmental programs. The PLATO system is a standard based, on-line learning program that targets the skills that learners need to improve to meet the requirements of college level studies. The systems reporting capabilities allow the students and instructors to monitor student progress and achievement and to pinpoint areas that require further study. Many faculty have integrated PLATO developmental modules into their curriculum either as graded work or extra credit in order to improve student success. Students can also use PLATO independently for ACCUPLACER, HESI, and Work Keys preparation, as well as subject area support. Our experience with PLATO as well as the level of integration through the College courses, website and learning center makes it the best solution for the College. Edmentum is the sole provider of PLATO.

The vendor has offered a 5% discounted price of \$127,443.75 for a three (3) year renewal (\$42,481.25 annually). The college is receiving an additional discounted price is due to the College's M-CAM PLATO purchase as approved by the Board of Trustees at the February 17, 2015 meeting.

Funding for this purchase will come from the College's technology accounts. User Department rationale is on the reverse side.

USER DEPARTMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF PLATO DEVELOPMENT LEARNING SYSTEM

PLATO was first introduced to the College through a grant-funded initiative with our high school partners through the Macomb Intermediate School District (MISD). When its purpose and success was realized after a two-year period, the software became 'institutionalized' and its versatility has allowed usage applications to increase regularly. Containing coursework appropriate for skill levels K through adult, many of our high school partners customize components of the PLATO coursework into actual course 'semesters'. This allows opportunities to enhance the classroom experience. High school students have also used PLATO for ACT/SAT test preparation.

As a service to the Macomb County community, the College is able to offer access to PLATO accounts free of charge. Many community members have requested the ESL modules to assist in English language skill building as they assimilate to this new area. A PLATO application also exists to assist in preparation for the TABE, ASVAB (*Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery), and ACT/SAT Workkeys tests. A module has been created to assist with preparation for the GED exam. Success on these exams builds bridges to the College for prospective students.

PLATO courseware modules contain tutorials, drills, applications, problem solving activities, reviews, practice, and mastery tests. Assessment tests diagnose and automatically prescribe individualized learning paths within a specific PLATO course for each learner. A wide variety of assessment strategies are available. Students can work independently on improving skills in grammar, writing, vocabulary, spelling, math, reading, study skills, English as a Second Language, keyboarding, and word processing. PLATO can be used to assess student skills, review old skills, get a head start on upcoming classes, study and practice new skills and take practice tests and quizzes. PLATO has the following standard curricula containing over 1,400 lessons in reading and writing, mathematics, life and career skills, and sciences. It is available for classes and for individual students.
