2. SEUSSICAL THE MUSICAL

We have approximately 70 students participate in a musical performance at LBMS on December 8th and 9th starting at 7:00 PM. The performers are students from Evergreen and Lorna Byrne Middle School. It is part of our transitions focus for the 21st Century After School Program.

3. WINTER SEASON FOR LBMS ATHLETICS-Began November 8, 2010. Only one athletic activity is in session at this time at LBMS. Boy's basketball began on November 8, 2010. We have 25 participants this year. November 30, the mighty Vikings of LBMS swept the Hanby Huskies of Gold Hill. Each team beat their opponent by 1 point.

4. 21ST CENTURY AFTER-SCHOOL ACTIVITIES – Began September 27th

After school activities, funded by the 21st Century Learning Grant, are available to all students. This year we have activities that include Evergreen students. We also have Homework Help House before classes begin Monday through Friday (except for Late Start Friday). This year, 21st Century is able to assist in the funding of operations for our Club Sport activities.
