Principal's General Narrative:

The High School faculty has finalized its incentive plan and it has been approved by the district advisory committee. It calls for each teacher to participate in activities such as after school and evening tutorials and periodic collaborative sessions in which data will be analyzed and ongoing planning will take place. With part of the grant funds we will purchase Study Island for high school. This online instructional program has proven to be very helpful in junior high to help identify areas in which students need help to pass the TAKS test. Grant funds will also reward support people that are not classroom teachers but who play a major role in helping to educate our children.

We have created a Junior High "High Achievers" leadership group that currently has 10 eighth graders and 5 seventh graders. At the end of each six weeks additional students will be able to join if they meet the criteria. We will meet each six weeks and have discussion on leadership and community service projects.

I and all the members of the high school appreciate the time, effort, and wisdom that school board members give on our behalf. We recognize that without the great leadership from the school board and Mrs. Renken our direction of continued and greater success would not be possible.
