RE: Teachers College Reading and Writing Project Summer Reading Institute

For the past three years, District 90 has been engaged in a partnership with Columbia University (NY) Teachers College Reading and Writing Project (TCRWP). This ongoing partnership has provided the district with high-quality, job-embedded professional develop to support the implementation of recently adopted reading and writing curriculum.

This summer, District 90 has the opportunity to host an optional four-day Summer Reading Institute August  $19^{th} - 21^{st}$  for grades K-8 to support continued implementation of the Units of Study for Teaching Reading. Topics addressed during the reading institute will include:

- Curriculum development based on decades of research and best practices
- Reading assessments
- Units of study in the reading workshop
- Classroom library development
- Fluency and comprehension strategy instruction
- Phonics as an integral component of early literacy
- Classroom structures that support inquiry and collaboration
- Formative assessments and learning progressions to develop data-based instruction in reading, including small group instruction
- Toolkits, charts and student-facing rubrics
- Writing about reading
- Reading, research, and cross-textual work in nonfiction
- Methods of holding students accountable for doing their best work
