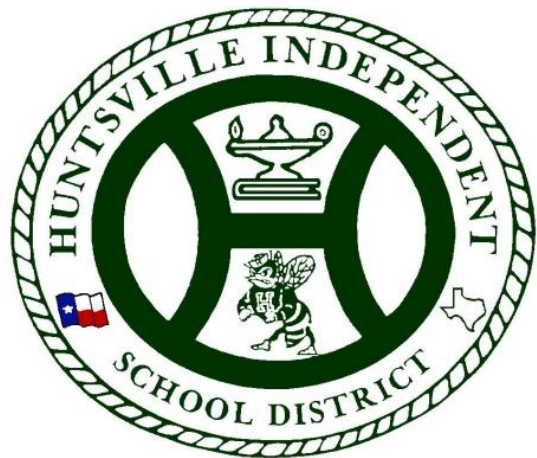

Steps to Increase Successful Student Participation in AP Exams

- Build the Honors and PreAP Program at MPMS. Targeted training currently in progress focused on critical thinking and analysis skills.
- HHS is part of the College Board Pre AP Program.
- AP teachers have attend specialized training.
- Place greater emphasis on the benefits of taking the exams and the expectation to test.
- Exams are paid for using both federal and local funds to ensure all students have access to take the exams.

Benefits of AP Exam



- More than **90 percent** of four-year U.S. colleges and universities grant **credit or placement** for qualifying AP Exam scores.
- Successful scores on AP exams allow students to **bypass intro-level coursework** or make it easier to double major or study abroad.
- AP students are **more likely** than their peers to **complete college within four years**.
- Students who take AP Exams say it makes them feel **more confident and prepared for college**.
- Taking the time to study for AP Exams helps students **better retain all that they learned** in class, and is likely to **prepare students for other college coursework in the subject**.

Note: HHS offered 12 different AP courses last year.

It is one way that we support our students' college and career goals. Dual Credit helps a broad population of students realize that college is an option for them.

- Builds confidence in their ability to be successful in college coursework.
- They leave high school with Lone Star College and/or SHSU admission already established.
- Able to earn college credits each semester.

Dual Credit and Advanced Placement

- Both programs provide opportunities for students to earn **college credit**.
- Guidance counseling helps students understand both options to make the **best choices for their college, career and financial goals**.
- Students can **take advantage of both programs** to meet their goals.
