



February 2025 - Activities Director Board Report

Strategic Planning Update:

Please see the live working scorecard for the Activities Department. Key notes listed below:

- **Student-Academic Eligibility Goal:** Percentage of students who have received a failing grade at the progress or quarters for their respective school has decreased for the 2024 - 2025 season.
 - AD continues to send out notices of D/F list to Head coaches two weeks prior to grades.
 - AD has also started sending the week before to try and prevent any academic ineligibilities.
- **Student-Engagement Surveys Goal:** Currently, percentage is above the goal for 2024 - 2025 school year through the completion of the fall activity season.
 - AD has followed the plan, and is getting the surveys out sooner to the students and multiple reminders in regards to filling out so their voices are heard.
- **Student-Participation Numbers Goal:** Currently, percentage is above the goal for 2024 - 2025 school year through the participation levels of clubs and winter athletics.
 - Put on a “Career Fair” type event during Link Crew day. The advisors noted this helped reach out to the incoming freshmen and had multiple new sign ups, which is being reflected in the numbers.
 - Growth of Girls’ Wrestling program has helped bolster athletic numbers with a group of individuals this being the first athletic based activity they have participated in while in high school.
 - District Surveys will have a large piece asking the public and students what we should have available to our students which will help direct future growth while working with Superintendent Wendell Quesinberry.
- **Student Retention in Activities Goal:** On Going
 - Currently date collecting to set a benchmark for future implementation and growth.
 - Overall trend, both Girls and Boys Basketball have lost the most students from the previous year without addition of students to the program resulting in low numbers. Wrestling program has gained the most students both on the boys and girls side of the program when compared to the previous year without suffering any losses.
- **Aid Community Education Program’s Growth Goal:** On Going
 - Currently continuing to work with Taylor Remington on needs, facility usage, and implementation of her program.
 - Continuing to date collect what classes are being offered when, while identifying community usage of the facility to better program facility usage in the future.
- **Community Communication Goal:** On Going
 - Continuing to get feedback from community members on what needs to be improved.
 - Pushed the new Hatchet App, and rschool App at the parent meetings so parents will receive updates as they happen.
- **Open-Line Communication Goal:** On Going
 - Continue to work with Coaching Staffs on implementation of the Coaches Handbook, School Policies, and proper communication protocol.

- Available at all times for Coaches to come in and communicate. Continue to forward any information I receive email in regards to games, tournaments, or WIAA to them directly.
- **Coaches / Advisor Satisfaction Goal:** Currently above the goal for the 2024 - 2025 season. As of right now 87.5% of Fall coaches have communicated they plan on returning next season.
 - Continue with Head Coach evaluations and implementing the Open-Line Communication Goal so that our Coaches feel valued and their voices are heard.
