1. Students begin school on August 4, 2011 and end school on May 18, 2012. This totals 180 student days, 90 in each semester.
2. Faculty will attend 93 days in the 1st semester and 92 days in the 2nd semester for a total of 185 days. There are five work days without students. Teachers will have four professional development days that are flexibly scheduled.
3. There are 26 holidays during the school year.
4. There are four scheduled 60% days where students will be dismissed 3 hours early to allow teachers to attend specialized training to support professional growth and effectiveness in efforts to enhance student achievement.
5. Pre-determined student make-up days, if school should be missed due to inclement weather will be as follows: Oct. 10, Feb. 20, and Apr. 9, and May 21-25.
6. There is an additional calendar which denotes academic dates such as exams, state testing, report cards, etc.
