



Community Education **Report – December 2021**

Classes

- We did not send out a Fall Community Education Booklet. We have been using flyers and Infinite Campus emails to get the word out about classes. This works very well.
- We had Tiger Cub Flag Football and Tiger Cub Volleyball this fall. Tiger Cub Flag Football had 36 participants and Tiger Cub Volleyball had 29 participants. Both classes had solid numbers returning from Covid-19 cancelations last fall.
- We will be holding Tiger Cub Basketball on a few Saturdays in January/February. Exact dates are not determined yet.

Driver Education

- We held a Summer 2021 Classroom Training Session in July with 24 students. Class was held in the Auditorium.
- Summer Behind the Wheel Training had 61 students complete their driving hours this past summer. Mr. Cole and Mr. Larson split time. With Mr. Cole leaving, we are looking for another instructor to help Mr. Larson. They must have a teaching license to teach through Community Ed.
- We are currently offering two Driver's Ed Classroom Training Sessions for this year. Classes are held in the Auditorium. Plays/Musicals may pose a conflict at some point in the future. Session 1 of the Classroom Training finished in early November and 26 students took the class. Session 2 will start in late February/early March. Registration has not started yet. We may offer a third summer class if there is a need for it. A survey was sent out, but didn't get many responses.
