- For any equipment or durable goods that have been purchased with this funding we ask that you consider gifting items to an Amphi colleague or teaching partner should you choose to leave the district.

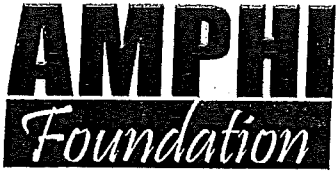

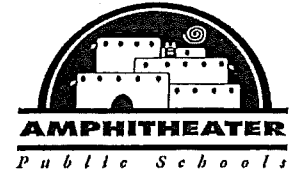

General purpose of the project:

To build a sustaining culture of kindness at our school.



Describe the project and how it will enhance the learning environment and promote academic excellence.

Project Synopsis:

A group of La Cima students and key staff people will form a group that will educate, promote & infuse campus with the benefits of kindness. Students will be drawn from the 7th grade Cardinal Ambassador team, an AVID class, and the Odyssey of the Mind class. Staff & student generated ideas will be used, in conjunction with materials and curriculum from the Bens Bells organization.

- >Design & build a Buddy Bench where students who need someone to talk to can go and be heard by a trained student 'buddy'. (STEAM activity)
- >Continuation and expansion of Kindness education on daily announcements, interactive bulletin boards.
- >Counselor lessons on building a "Kind Mind" that includes evidence based information on the impact of intentional kindness & the science behind our mental experience.
- >Promotion of student art entries into the Bens Bells Mosaic Stepping Stone project. (STEAM activity)
- >Student generated interactive skits that present situations where students have to decide to choose kindness. Student leaders would facilitate learning with the skits in 1st period classes (3rd Qtr). (PBL activity)
- >Possible creation of a 'kindness' app or organizing a digital kindness mentor program among feeder pattern. (STEM activity)

Evaluation and Sustainability plan:	A pre and post survey will be conducted among the student body, staff and parents to measure perception of how kind our campus is in Oct 2018 vs. May 2019. The project will be sustainable because the materials from Ben's Bells are available to us once signed up as a Kind Campus. We also plan to have students help with fundraising to work toward the cost of a Ben's Bells mosaic, and to be involved in the implementation of that mosaic when there are sufficient funds (target date Oct. 2019)
