Background and Rationale: The Texas Association of School Boards has submitted this renewal proposal to provide the College's Worker's Compensation insurance. They assist the College with ideas and grants that help us reduce workplace injuries. The current proposal represents an approximate increase of \$2,100.00 over last year's premium. It is our recommendation that we accept their offer and have them remain as the College's provider of Worker's Compensation Insurance. The proposed amount is based on estimated payroll and could vary slightly but the rate is fixed. Under section 791 of the Texas Government Code, districts may contract with one another and other agencies of the State for the purpose of increasing their efficiency and effectiveness.
