



OFFICIAL RETURNS AND SUMMARY STATEMENTS OF JUDGES OF SPECIAL ELECTION
AS TO VOTE ON THE CAPITAL PROJECT LEVY AUTHORIZATION QUESTION OF
INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 2167 (LAKEVIEW), MINNESOTA

The undersigned, being the judges duly appointed for the special election held in and for Independent School District No. 2167 (Lakeview), Minnesota, on November 4, 2025, hereby certify that we attended the polling places for the election, located at the Cottonwood Community Center, 142 W Main St, Cottonwood Minnesota and Wood Lake Community Center, 88 2nd Ave W, Wood Lake, Minnesota, in the School District, on the date of the election; that the polls for the special election were duly opened at 12:00 o'clock (noon) p.m. and remained open continuously until 8:00 o'clock p.m. on said day and no longer; that the number of ballots delivered to the precinct as adjusted by the actual count made by the election judges was **1,000 and 400** respectively, that the number of unofficial ballots made was **0**, and that the number of absentee ballots delivered to the precinct was **200 and 100** respectively; that the number of defective ballots was **0**, that the number of spoiled ballots was **1**, that the number of duplicate ballots made was **0**, that the number of absentee ballots rejected was **0**, and that that the number of unused ballots was **1,686**; that all qualified voters residing in the election precinct in which the polling place is located who appeared to vote there at were permitted to do so and that the number of individuals who voted at the election in the precinct was **454** which is equal to the number of ballots cast in the precinct; that the number of voters registering to vote on election day in the precinct was **7**; that each person who voted was furnished by us with an official ballot in form identical with the one hereto attached; and that the special election was otherwise in all respects conducted according to law. We further certify that forthwith upon the closing of the polls for the special election, we proceeded to count the votes cast at the polling place on the capital project levy authorization question contained in the ballot, and thereupon found and determined and do hereby certify that all of the ballots cast were properly piled, checked and counted; and that the numbers entered on this summary statement correctly show the number of votes cast for and against the question. The undersigned hereby certify and declare that the votes on the question were as follows:

**School District Question
Capital Project Levy Authorization**

The board of Independent School District No. 2167 (Lakeview), Minnesota has proposed a capital project levy authorization in the maximum amount of 2.061% times the net tax capacity of the School District. The proposed capital project levy authorization will raise approximately \$250,000 for taxes first levied in 2025, payable in 2026, and will be authorized for ten (10) years. The estimated total cost of the projects to be funded over that time period is approximately \$2,500,000. The proposed authorization will provide funds for enhancing safety and security, Career and Technology Education programs and equipment, classroom and building technology, digital curriculum, technology infrastructure and network improvements, device replacement, and the costs of technology-related personnel and training. The projects to be funded have received a positive review and comment from the Commissioner of Education.
