What has changed?

1. Definition of "Up to Date" for vaccinations (communication will go out to all staff/families today)

Takes effect 1/18/22

Vaccination Status	Definition (will be updated as info is released) No waiting period after booster
Up to Date	Staff:
Not Up to Date	Anyone: • Unvaccinated • Has only received the 1st shot of Pfizer or Moderna Staff: • Completed both shots of Pfizer or Moderna more than 5 months ago with no booster • Completed the shot of J&J more than 2 months with no booster

2. Contact tracing rules Takes effect 1/18/22

- a. Inside the building only contact tracing if either party was unmasked, within 6', cumulative 15+ minutes
- b. Most likely will only apply to:
 - i. Unmasked while eating
 - ii. Unmasked while waiting in line in cafeteria
 - iii. Unmasked during extracurricular activities (band, choir, welding etc)

3. Definition of an inside exposure

- a. Any individual unmasked within 6 ft for 15 or more minutes, indoor within a 24 hour period of time
- 4. For positive staff and students who have been exposed (including off-campus exposures), 5 day quarantine (STAFF 5 day quarantine starts 1/18/22, STUDENT 5 day quarantine starts with any case 1/21 onward)
 - a. A staff who tests positive or has been exposed can return on the 6th day IF they feel better, symptoms improving, and have been fever free for 24 hours.

- b. Upon return for days 6-10, staff must wear a mask at all times (including recess duty), and eat in isolation away from anyone else.
- c. If the staff member is not able to wear a mask at all times or eat in isolation, they must stay in quarantine for the full 10 days.

Things to think about...

When **positive** students return early, they must do the following for days 6-10: wear a mask at all times (including extra curricular!) and eat at least 6' away from others.

- → When are students unmasked in your building?
 - a. PE?
 - b. Walking to lunch?
 - c. Standing in line at lunch?
 - d. Eat at least 6' away from another individual
 - e. Band/Choir?
 - f. Recess?
 - g. Extra curricular activities?
