Upcoming Testing Opportunity for Seniors planning to attend a 4-yr college/university next fall:

SAT's: Wednesday, October 13th, 8:30 am. Students can reserve their spot by contacting Esther. Cost is \$55 unless you qualify for the free/reduced lunch program which you can sign up for through Mealtime. Fee waivers available from Esther for those who qualify. These fee waivers can also be used for college applications!.

Also for seniors: October is FAFSA completion month and all seniors are expected to create their FSA ID as well as complete and submit their FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). The FAFSA is the foundation of all financial aid packages for colleges and other post-secondary training programs.

Students will need their social security number and their 2020 tax returns if they filed last year. One parent will also need to have an FSA ID (many of you already have one for older siblings!) and your 2020 tax returns in order for the student to submit their FAFSA. Appointments can be made during SLC's for those wanting assistance in completing the FAFSA or any other time by contacting Esther. esthert@nknsd.org 503 355-3588
