Subject: Consider Approval of an ILA-BuyBoard Contract for the Victory Lakes Intermediate School Gym Floor Repair Project				
Background: Capital Projects Funds (Bonds 2023 Project Savings) are approved for the roof replacement at Victory Lakes Intermediate. While replacing the roof over both gymnasiums, both gym floors sustained water damage due to rain infiltration. To expedite this repair, we will contract directly with Bauer Sport Floors and request that the roofer reimburse us for costs related to the water damage. We recommend awarding the total contract value of \$75,000.00 to Bauer Sport Floors, which includes a contingency of \$2,650.00. This project has a target completion date of August 2024.
