

Elementary and Intermediate School Technology Use Agreement Lewiston-Altura School District #857

Lewiston-Altura Public School District provides elementary and intermediate students devices to use in our digital learning environment. Similar to textbooks, daily use of devices will cause wear and tear and there will be expected needs for occasional repairs. Students are expected to take care of the device and practice appropriate computer procedures. Intentional damage to devices is not acceptable. Students in grades Kindergarten – Grade 6 have access to devices in their classrooms. Kindergarten- Grade 6 students that intentionally damage a device may be asked to pay for the repair costs for the device. In the event of required distance learning, devices will be checked out to all Kindergarten – Grade 6 students for use at home. Students and families are expected to keep the devices in good working order and return them to school when requested.
