Since returning from winter break, our classroom has jumped right back into learning! Students have begun an exciting astronomy unit, where we are exploring

the sun, moon, and stars while building background knowledge and vocabulary through reading, discussion, and hands-on activities. In math, we are working on measurement by comparing lengths and heights using a variety of tools, encouraging students to estimate, measure, and explain their thinking. It has been wonderful to see students engaged, curious, and eager to share their learning as we start the new year together.

3RD & 4TH GRADE WITH TEACHER CARLA

Our class has officially kicked off CKLA Unit 4: **Eureka—Inventions!**, and they are already buzzing with excitement. We began the unit by learning about the biographies of famous inventors, exploring who they were, what inspired them, and how their inventions changed the world. This unit places a strong emphasis on collaboration, giving students many opportunities to work together, share ideas, ask questions, and learn from one another.

Through teamwork, thoughtful discussions, and hands-on activities, students are having a lot of fun while building a deeper understanding of how inventions are created and why innovation matters.



5TH GRADE WITH TEACHER MECHEAL

Students used models and scale to explore how far space is and the objects we find beyond Earth. Using linking cubes, they created scaled models to represent the distances of familiar landmarks and space objects such as Mount Everest, where space begins, the International Space Station, and the Hubble Space Telescope.

This hands-on activity helped students visualize and compare distances that are normally hard to imagine, deepening their understanding of scale, measurement, and the vastness of space through active exploration and discussion.

MIDDLE SCHOOL & HIGH SCHOOL WITH TEACHER GRETA

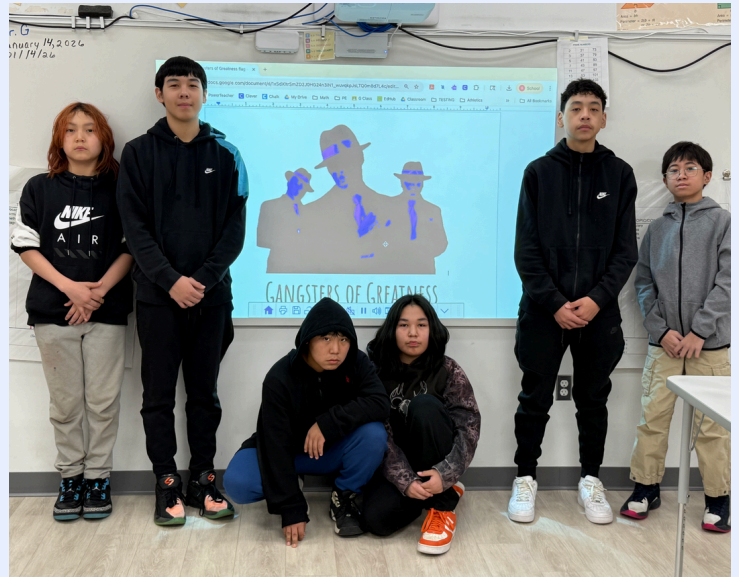
In our middle school and high school Tumitchiat Sivunmun classes, students have been divided into teams for the semester. One team—made up of Colin Ahkivgak-Agnasagga, Cameron Fishel, Alexis Hopson Brower, Eli Kingik, Adrian Kippi Kagak, Clayborne Kippi, Adam Polte, and Rob Punla—is now working with Dr. G.

This week, students completed a team interest inventory and researched ideas for group names. After thoughtful discussion, they proudly chose the name **“Gangsters of Greatness.”** Their team motto is: *“Together we will conquer them all!”*

Dr. G’s Gangsters of Greatness established three goals for the spring semester:

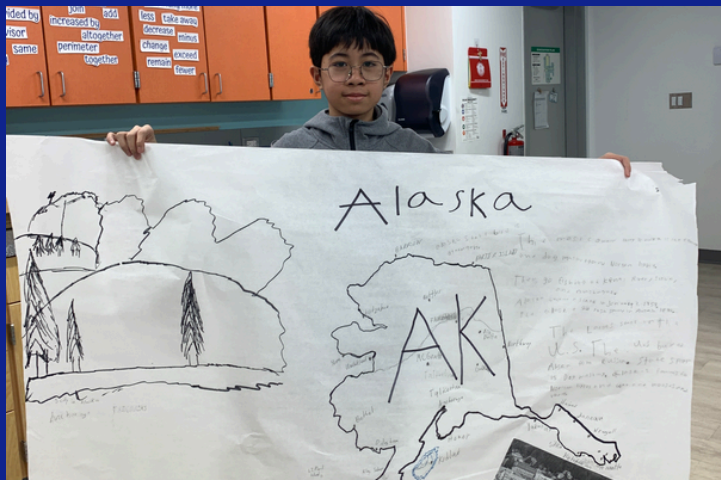
1. Maintain **90% or higher attendance** each week

MIDDLE SCHOOL WITH TEACHER JAMES

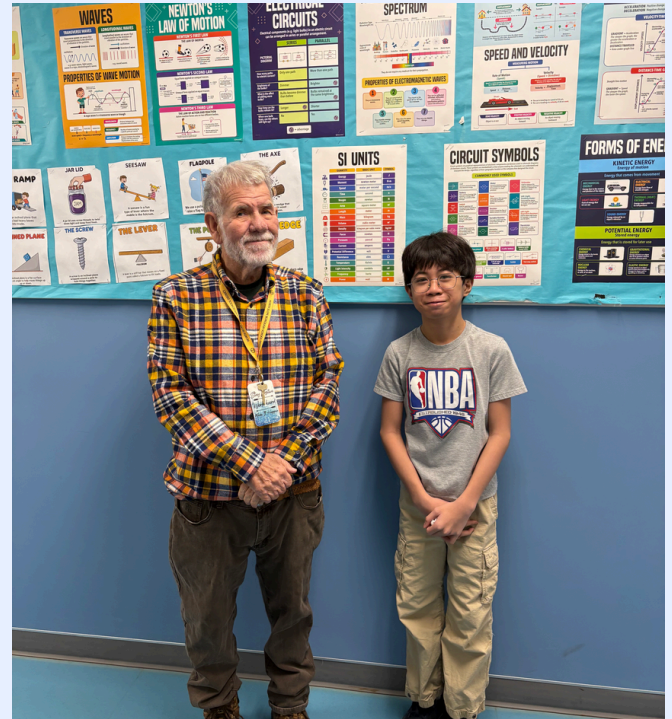
In Middle School Social Studies, the class is learning about US geography. This week students are working on posters of an individual state. They will include information on important cities, rivers, tourism, and major industries.

In High School Social Studies, students are learning about the history and government that has effected alaska and the North Slope. This week we have focused on Russian colonialism in Alaska, why Russian sold Alaska to the US, the Dawes Act, and Elizabeth Peratrovich, a Tlinkit native who gained Alaska natives equal rights before any US state achieved equal rights.

Group "C" Team Spotlight

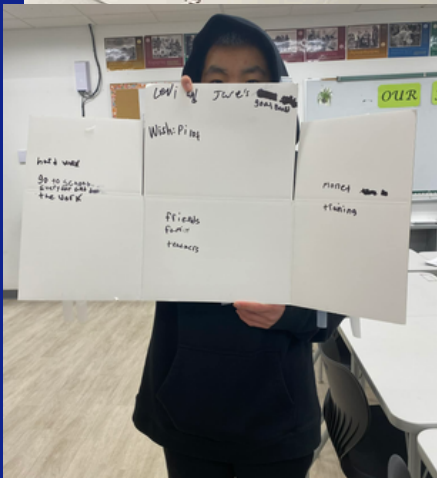
Rihanna and her teammates proudly created their group, Happy Gang. Together, they established the following safety rules: no bullying, respect one another, and wear shoes always.
