REASON FOR BOARD CONSIDERATION:

Board review is required for offerings that are submitted to the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) for approval.

BACKGROUND:

It is a requirement of Oregon SB233 for public post-secondary institutions to award and transcript the Core Transfer Map (CTM). If a student successfully completes a Core Transfer Map, all the credits from that map are guaranteed to transfer to any Oregon public university and count toward its core bachelor's degree requirements. All MTM supporting degrees include the CTM as part of the program requirements.

BUDGET IMPACT/SOURCE OF FUNDS:

Students who are completing the CTM requirements are already being supported, mostly through MTM supporting degrees. Therefore, students completing the CTM are currently supported by Student Services and Campus Facilities and will continue to do so.
