ACT Preparation

• Increase ACT scores by 10%

BHS has been gearing up for the ACT which will be on March 24. For our writing Assessment we fashioned it like the timed writing portion of the ACT. All students grades 9–12 were introduced to this new format.

Gear Up staff has been assisting with ACT prep in grade 11 advisory for the timed math portion as well and effective strategies for test taking.

Having these opportunities to be exposed to the format, and time schedule of the ACT test has been very eye opening.

Sophomores will be taking the Pre ACT on April , which will give them the opportunity to see and practice the test.

ACT Social Emotional Learning portion (TESSERA)

All freshman were given the TESSERA assessment. The ACT Tessera Social and Emotional Learning Assessment System was developed to measure social and emotional skills that are associated with success in school, career, and life. The system can be used by educators to select, develop, and implement programs or interventions to improve these skills in children and adolescents. This was new this year and students were excited by this new assessment.
