### **Current Work**

- Staff is beginning to prepare for Forward Testing that will occur in April

#### **Current Work**

- Students will be taking the YRBS survey on March 19th. We had to push the date back from March 5th due to school being cancelled due to inclement weather. This was also pushed back to allow time to communicate with families about the survey and give families on the choice on whether or not to have their child participate

  - 7th Grade students will be taking part in Mini Business World on March 12th.
