



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Relationship Building

- Daily 15-minute transition time into the school day to help students prepare for learning

Behavior Monitoring

- RAISE Staff track student data for both academics and behavior on a daily basis
- Staff-Directed Reflection
- Student Self-Reflection
- Review of coping skills and self-directed approaches to conflict management
- Weekly Goal Setting

- RAISE Academy Team Collaboration
 - RAISE Staff meets at least twice daily to discuss student progress and adjust practices if necessary
 - Continual assessment of current practices
 - Daily review of student data to inform staff decision-making process
