News & Notes:

- We have been collaborating with the Business Office and Activities Director to revamp concessions for Athletic events & other special event offerings. A Concessions Manager has been hired and we will be working to expand the offerings starting with the Winter Sports Season. We are very excited to have a more consistent and robust concessions experience for our community.

Current Offerings:

- Fall Youth Sports are wrapping up. We will be opening registrations for the Winter Youth Sports November 1st. Currently planned activities include:

Little Rangers Family Center:

- We made some staffing assignment changes in the Family Center to best fill our current needs and to ensure we were serving as many families as possible. Through this change, we were able to open another section of Little Rangers (4's/School Readiness) and enroll all those on the waiting list.
- The Fall ECFE classes have started. We are looking to expand the ECFE offerings and add an evening option to accommodate working families.
- The Family Center is offering three open house nights throughout the school year in addition to the ECFE Gym Nights that have been offered in the past.
- Ranger Care is currently full with 25 families receiving before and/or after school care.
