#### **Details**

### **North Layton Junior High School**

**Reason for Amendment:** Due to an unanticipated surplus from personnel-related expenses for the 2024-2025 school year, North Layton Junior High School has surplus LAND Trust funds for the current school year.

- Current Academic Core Growth Goal (no changes needed):
- 1. By the end of the 2025 academic year, North Layton Junior High will increase student growth scores in the areas of English Language Arts, Math, and Science by an average of two points per state tested area.
- Proposed Action Plan Amendments for Academic Goals:

Re-allocate \$5,156 in unanticipated surplus funds to update and increase classroom and student technology to support effective classroom instruction to facilitate increased student learning. This will include replacing and upgrading classroom audio enhancement systems and classroom projection systems.
