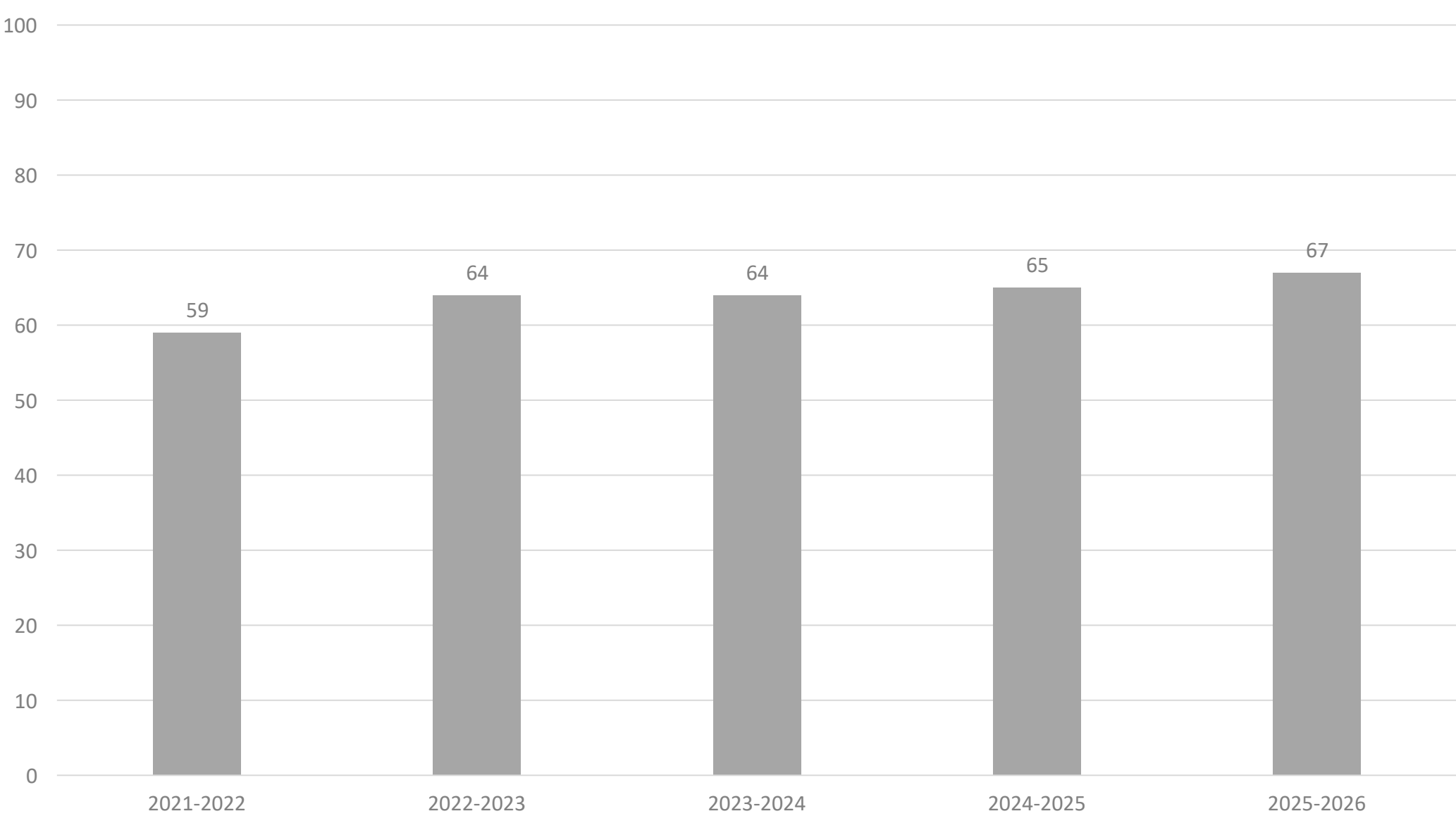

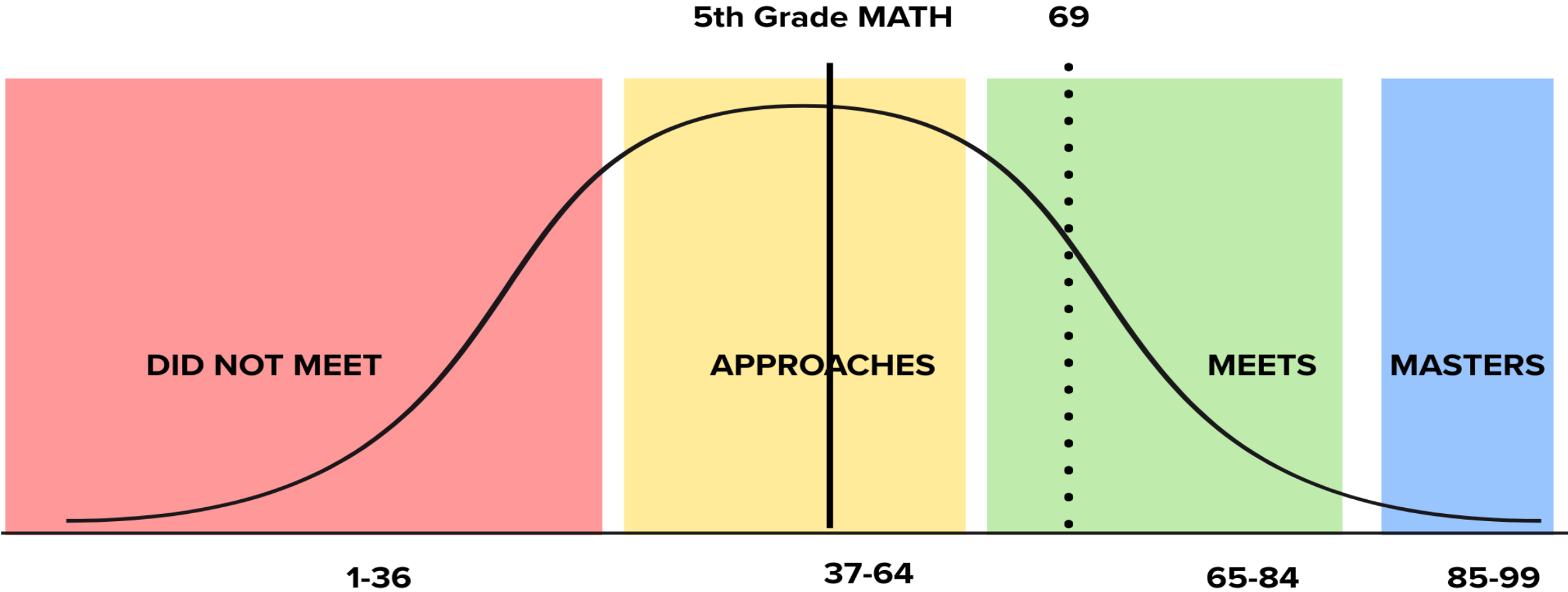
MAP Achievement Comparison to Nation



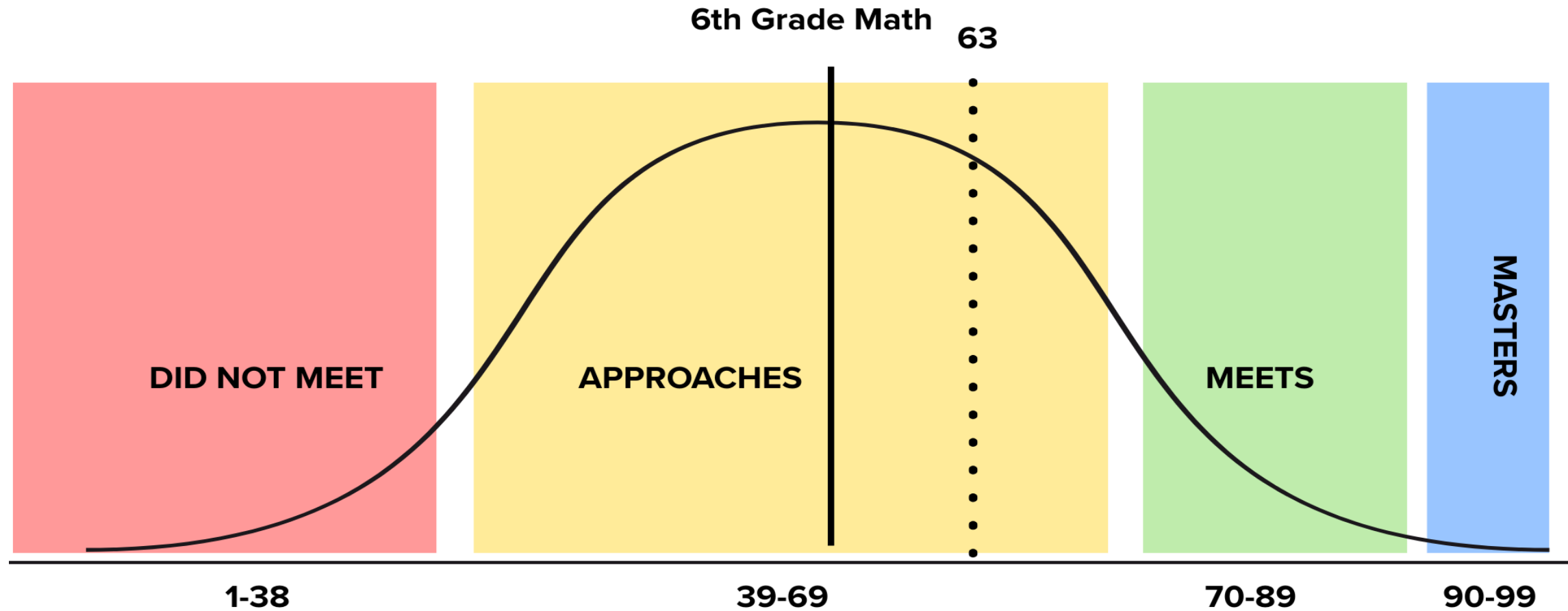
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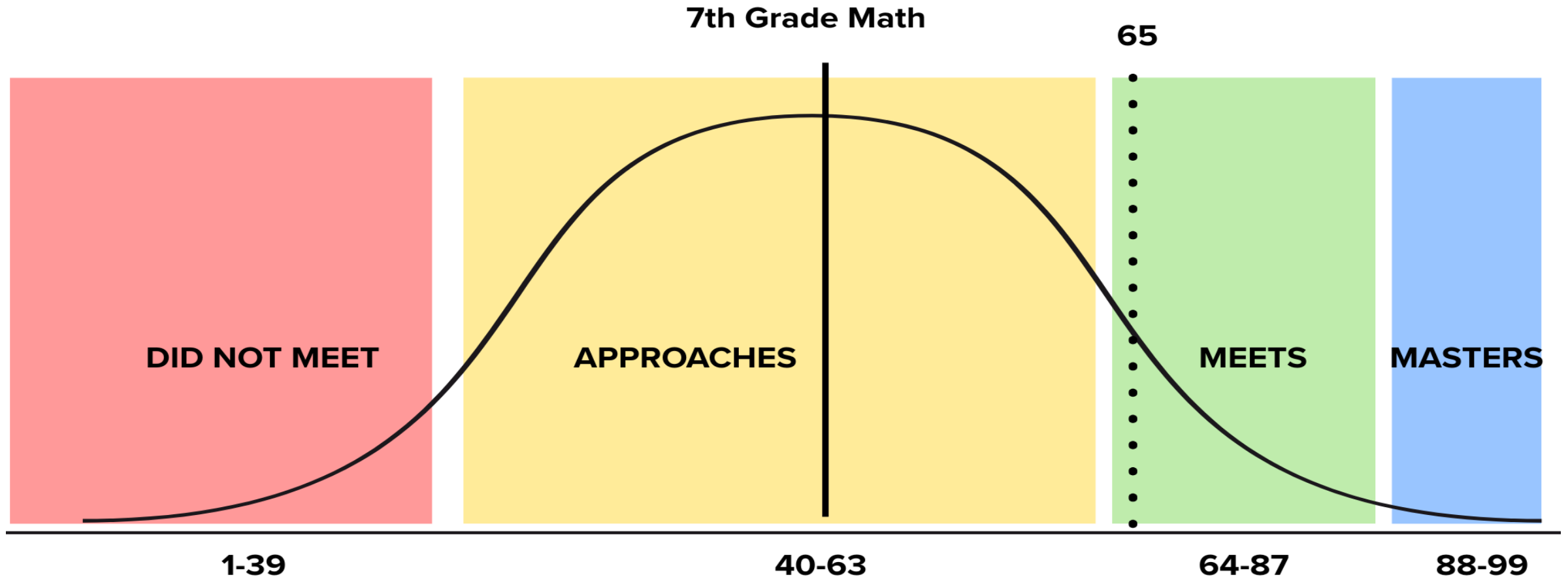
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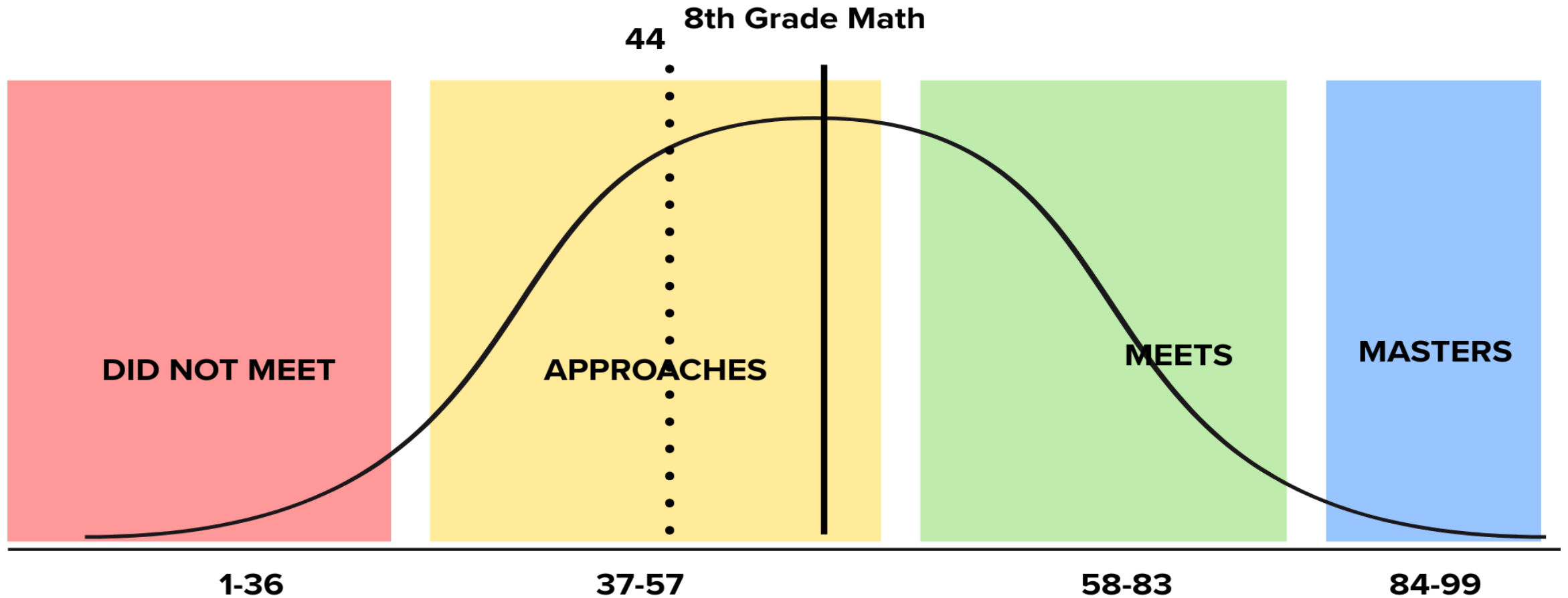
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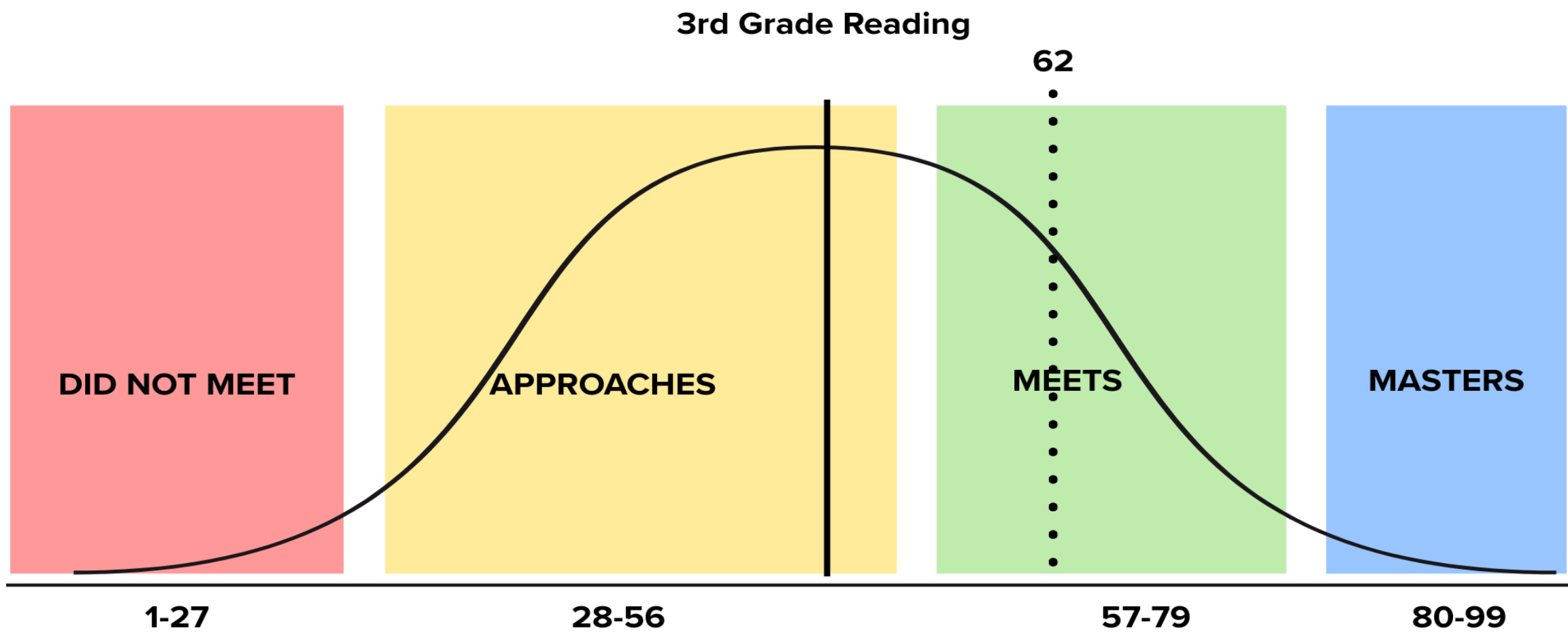

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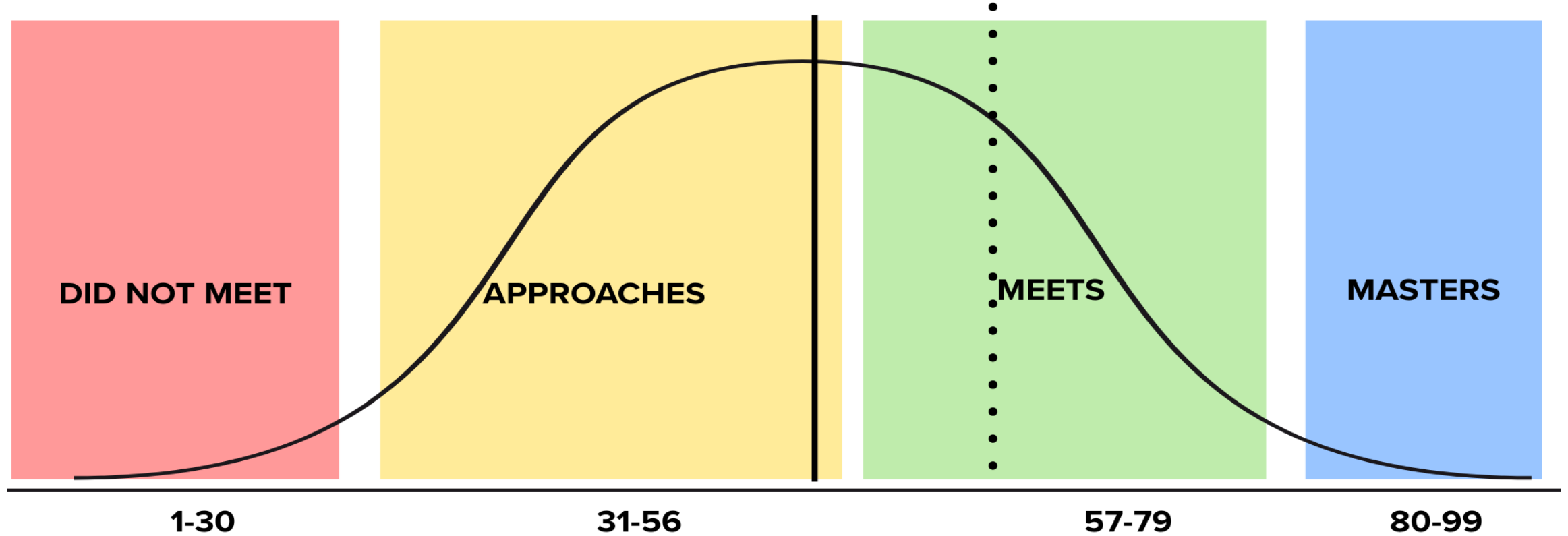
5th Grade Reading



MAP Achievement Comparison to Nation

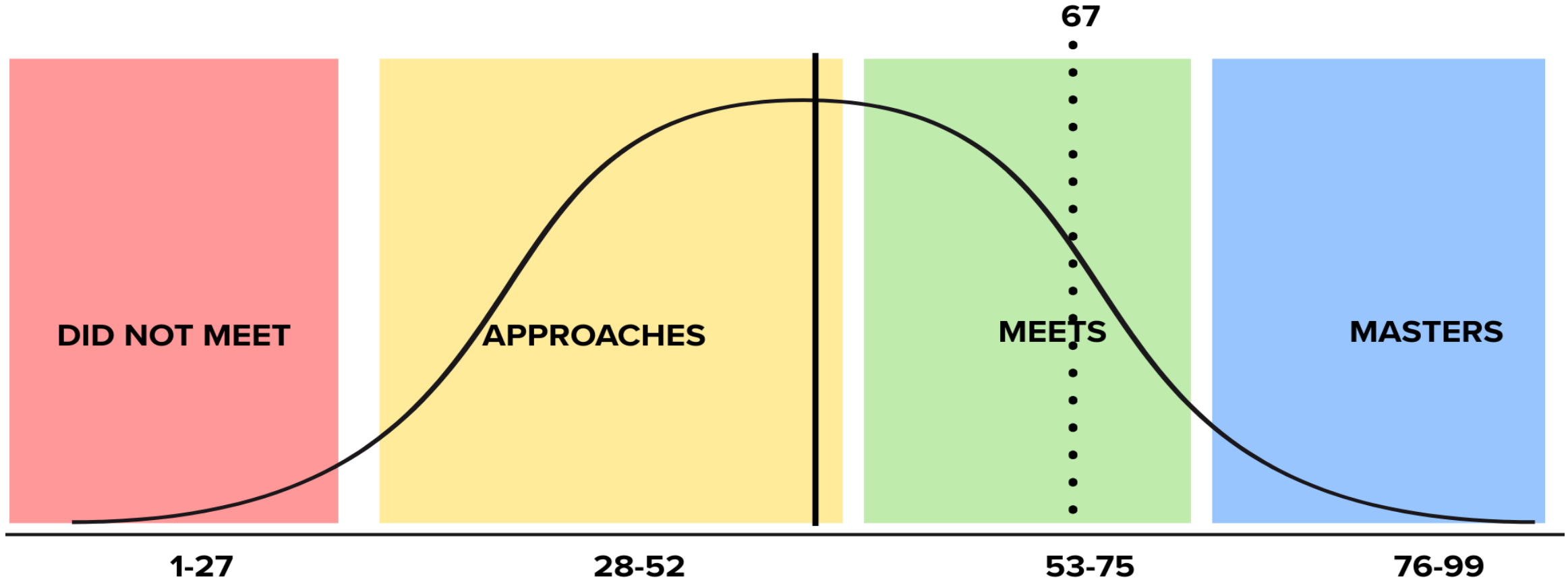
6th Grade Reading

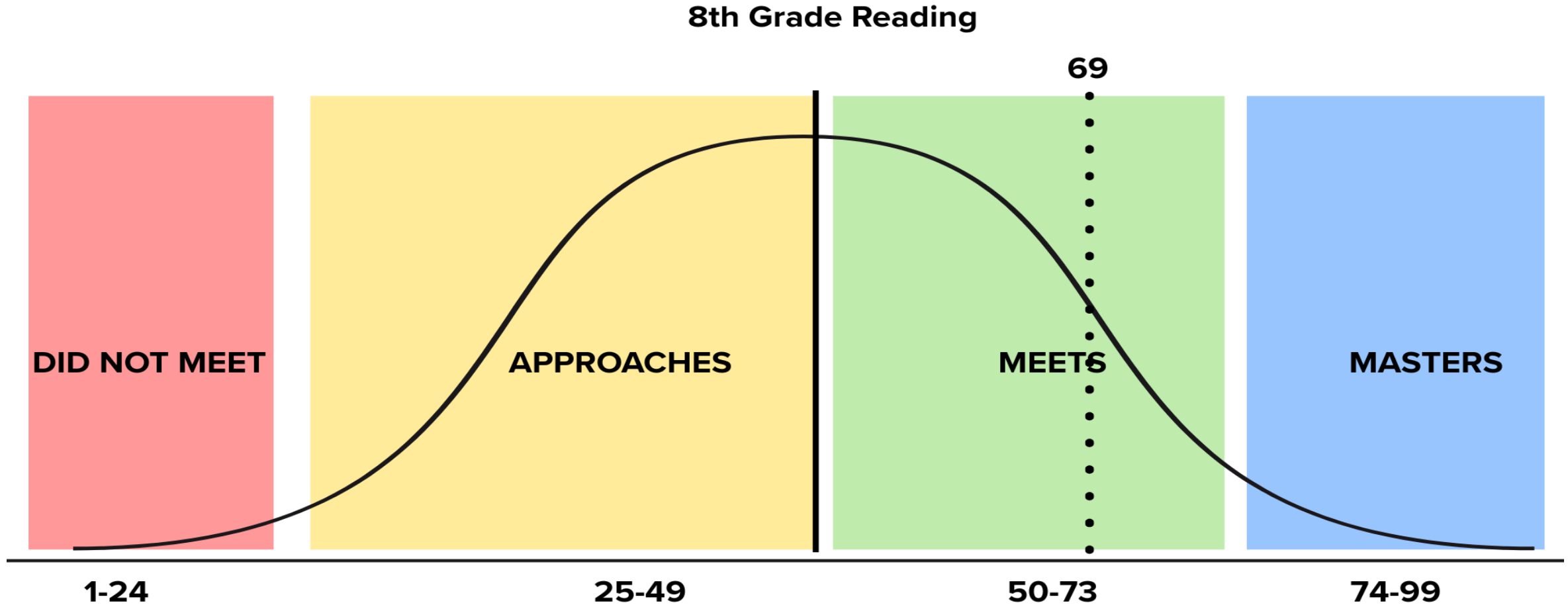


MAP Achievement Comparison to Nation

7th Grade Reading

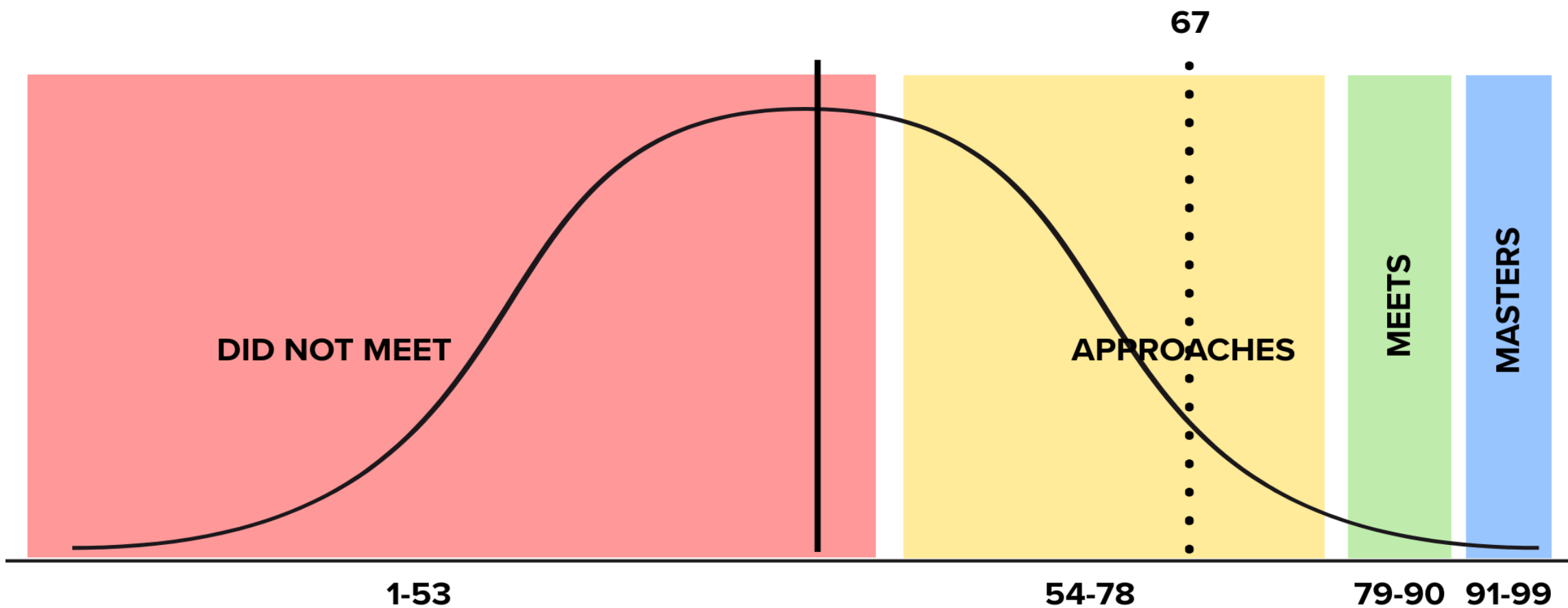

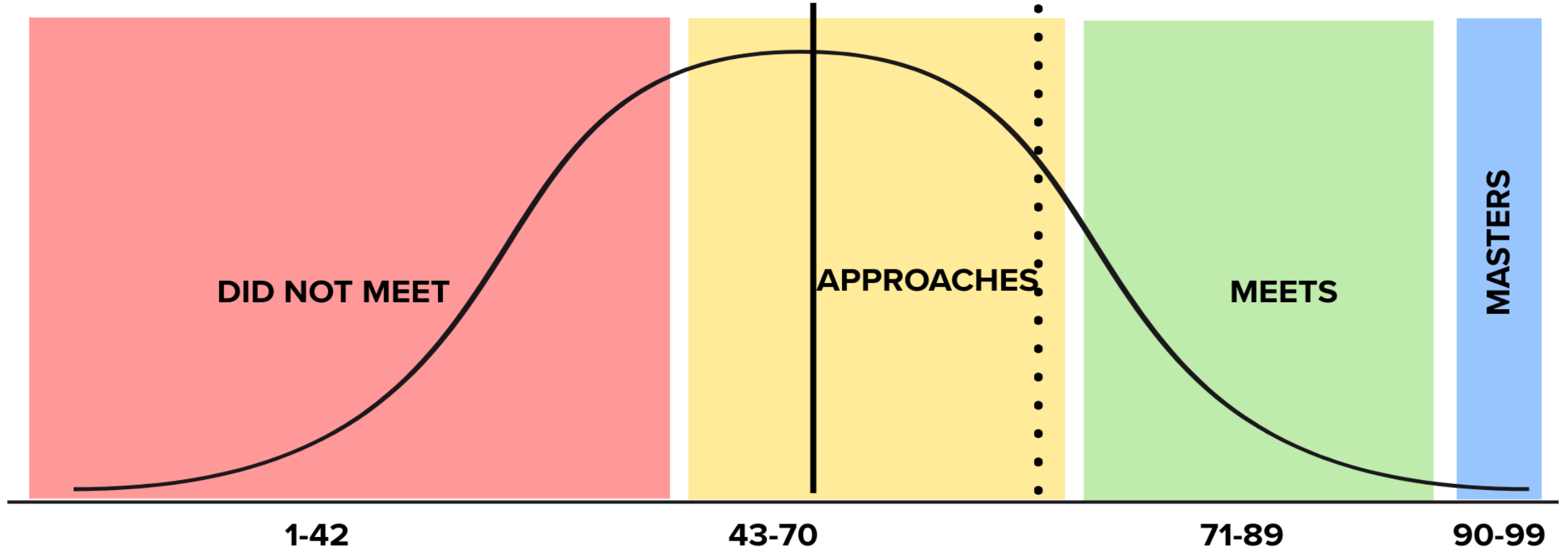

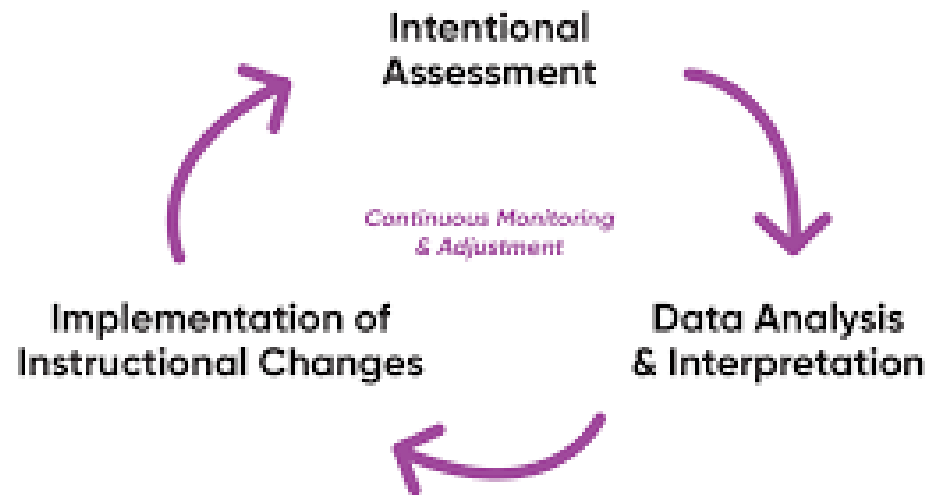
