<u>Community Service</u>: In order to make the honor roll, students must complete a minimum of 7 hours of community service per trimester. Activities for relatives, individuals, or private businesses will not be approved. No payment or wages may be received for activities in consideration for service time. Approved activities include work done for non-profit organizations. For each activity, the student will need a signature and the contact information from the supervising adult. December 4th through 8th is National Handwashing Awareness Week!

Clean hands prevent sickness. Teach your students to wash hands anytime they are visibly dirty and before meals. Try to keep hands

away from the face, eyes and mouth to prevent the spread of germs. Practice at home and notice if your student is able to wet, lather, scrub, and rinse for at least 20-30 seconds before drying. Singing the "Happy Birthday" song twice is about the right length of time. Good handwashing is a simple and effective way to keep everyone healthy!


