Subject: Presentation and Recommendation of 2025 Tentative Tax Levy

Attached are a PowerPoint presentation and associated statistical information regarding the development of our 2025 Tentative Property Tax Levy, which is being presented for your review and approval tonight. This tentative tax levy must be reviewed and approved by the Board of Education at least 20 days before the presentation and approval of a final tax levy in December. I would like to run through the presentation and highlight some information, as background for the tentative levy being presented therein. If there are any questions about the information provided or the tentative levy developed from it, I would be happy to answer them at that time. As the 2025 Tax Levy Request will be less than 105% of the prior year's Tax Levy Extension, we will not be required to comply with the Truth in Taxation Act and hold a public hearing on the tax levy, or post a notice of a public hearing prior to the final levy being presented and approved in December. We will certify in December that we were not required to comply with the Truth in Taxation Act as part of the Final Tax Levy Presentation and Approval process. As always, please let me know if you have any questions or need additional information. Thank you.

RECOMMENDATION

It is the recommendation of the Administration that the Board approve the 2025 Tentative Property Tax Levy totaling \$49,500,000, as presented herein. As the proposed increase is less than 105% of the prior year's tax extension of \$47,557,588, a notice and a public hearing on the tax levy in December are not required under the Truth in Taxation Act. With Board approval of this Tentative Tax Levy in November (at least 20 days before any final action), the Administration will keep the Tentative Tax Levy on file and available for public inspection in the Business Office and post it on the District website until the December 15th Board Meeting. In December, we will confirm compliance with the Truth in Taxation Act and request approval of the final tax levy. Once the final tax levy is approved, the Administration will file the Certificate of Levy, the associated Levy Resolution and all accompanying documentation with the DuPage County Clerk and the DuPage County Regional Office of Education by the fourth Tuesday in December, as required by law.
