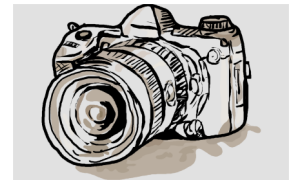

### TITLE ONE

Applegate School is a Title 1 School. Title 1-A is the United States Government's largest educational assistance program for schools. The funds received from Title 1 are used to provide programs to help children who are struggling in reading and math by providing extra help in addition to the core classroom instruction. This is a school wide program and all students are eligible to receive services. Student's progress is closely monitored and adjustments to instruction are made throughout the year as needed. Parent's rights include the right to request teacher qualifications, opportunities to meet with staff, plan and participate in decision making.
