Invitation for Browning Public Schools Staff to Join a Native Languages Study Group

On behalf of the Lower Kuskokwim School District, Alaska, I am inviting two members of the Browning Public Schools to join an inter-tribal, inter-state Native Languages Study Group. We have received a five-year grant from the Office of English Language Acquisition, U.S. Department of Education, to develop an assessment system for our Alaska Native language, Yugtun.

The grant includes funding to establish a small Study Group of inter-tribal and inter-state native and non-native educators interested in initiating or expanding their native language curricula and assessment. The Montana Office of Public Instruction suggested that staff from the Browning Public Schools may be interested in joining the group. Currently the Native Study Group includes members of the Menominee Indian Tribe in Wisconsin, Central Yup'ik Eskimo expert teachers and district administrators from Alaska, and researchers from WIDA and the Linguistics Department, University of Wisconsin-Madison.

The Principal Investigator, Ms. Gayle Miller, Alaska, and Dr. Rosalie Grant, a WIDA researcher, will jointly facilitate regular online group discussions and one two-day field trip each year. My district is happy to host the first field trip on Wednesday, 26 April to Thursday, 27 April, 2017. Participants would need to arrive in Bethel, Alaska, by the evening of April 25. The field trip will include visiting Ayaprun Elitnaurvik Immersion School in Bethel and a remote village school that is part of our Yugtun Dual Language program. Please find attached a draft agenda for the site visit to our district.

If two of your staff are interested in joining the Study Group, the grant can pay travel, lodging, meals and incidental expenses at government rates for one site visit per year. We are hoping members of the Study Group will be willing to host annual site visits on a rotational basis. Other people are welcome to participate in Study Group discussions and site visits at their own expense.

We would be delighted if your staff joined the collaborative Native Study Group. Your people would have an opportunity to see and learn about other native immersion programs and native centric curricula. We will have an opportunity to learn from your experiences in native language immersion education.
