A Regular Meeting of the Board of Trustees of Frisco ISD was held Monday, February 9, 2026, beginning at 6:30 pm at the Frisco ISD Administration Building, 5515 Ohio Drive, Frisco, TX.

- Mr. Jessen spoke regarding the FAQs on the District website along with who can add agenda items onto the Board Meeting Agenda and why it's two Board members versus just one Board member.

7. Board Report

- Mrs. Salas shared that this weekend we have approximately 60 students that will be traveling to Houston to compete in our State Championship Wrestling and there is a student representing every single one of our high schools. She also stated that Reedy and Wakeland won their District 9-5a Swimming and Diving titles, and several other swimmers and divers received individual championships also.
- Mrs. Elad shared that yesterday, Mrs. Sample, Mrs. Salas and she had the opportunity to volunteer at the Refresh North Texas where they hand out the packets to the families and how it's a great organization. There is a link to it on her Facebook page in case people want to support. For those who aren't aware, as she wasn't aware of this organization before she joined the board, they help students to get personal hygiene products including toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, body wash, and all those things. They serve Frisco ISD students as well as a couple other neighboring districts and do a lot of really great work. Mrs. Elad stated she brought her 9th grader with her and they had a good time meeting the families who were also grateful and appreciative. They also helped restock shelves and it was a great experience.

- Mrs. Sample also enjoyed the visit to Frisco Refresh North Texas because it's Community Service and that's one thing that just makes you have a good heart. She also had the opportunity to visit Lawler to see the Lawler Middle School send-off. They are going to the State Competition for Orchestra, and their performance was outstanding for middle school. They moved the instruments around on the floor, and sang along with solos. She thoroughly enjoyed the send-off and stated that the send-off was just a little taste of what they're going to do at the competition, and she can't wait to see hear the outcome.
- Mr. Manduva shared that last week with a few other fellow trustees, they had the opportunity to meet with the Superintendent Student Advisory Council at their monthly meeting at the CTE Center. They had one on one chats along with chats with multiple groups. They asked questions regarding what future course they would you like to see that are not currently offered in Frisco ISD. They shared great ideas, and he would like to share those ideas with Dr. Cunningham. He enjoyed interacting with the Superintendent Student Advisory Council that is made up of 9-12 graders from each high school. Mr. Manduva was thankful for the opportunity.

She hopes that all of the information that is shared with them, they take back out into the community to share with others in hopes that they will come in next year and participate.
