RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE UNITED INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPPORTING THE

United College Assistance Now ("UCAN") for Educators

WHEREAS, The United Independent School District ("UISD"), a political subdivision of the State of Texas, provides its high school students the opportunity to receive college course credit by participating in Dual Enrollment Courses, and

WHEREAS, UISD full-time teachers interested in teaching the Dual Enrollment Courses must not only meet State Certification teaching requirements but the Certification must be coupled with either a Master's Degree from an accredited university in certain content areas, or a Masters Degree not conferred in the content areas but must have a minimum of eighteen (18) hours of college credit in the content area beyond their Master Degree; and

WHEREAS, UISD's Curriculum and Instruction Department has targeted the following areas of Instruction to be deemed "content course areas" for teaching purposes in the Dual Enrollment Courses, those being in either (1) Art, (2) English, (3), Math, (4) Science, (5) Psychology, (6) Speech, (7) U.S. History, (8) Sociology, or (9) Business Information Management; Spanish; and other areas as determined by Administration; and

WHEREAS, UISD full time teachers wishing to participate in the UCAN for Educators Program must have classroom teaching experience in the content course areas as prescribed by the UISD's Curriculum and Instruction Department and the Department of Human Resources; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that a public purpose would be served in expending public funds to pay for *tuition and fees* to current UISD full-time teachers interested in participating in the UCAN for Educators Program" in order for these UISD teachers to be able to meet the educational requirements to teach in UISD's Dual Enrollment Courses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

Section 1. The United Independent School District Board of Trustees approves the United College Assistance Now (UCAN) for Educators Program which will provide for tuition and fees assistance to UISD Full Time Teachers interested in participating in the UCAN for Educators Program in order to receive the educational requirements needed to be able to teach

Dual Enrollment Courses.

United College Assistance Now (U-CAN) for Educators Program Content Area Master's Degree or 18 Hours Beyond Master's for Eligibility to Instruct Dual Enrollment Courses

Purpose

In our mission to provide high quality instruction and foster the professional growth of our teachers, United Independent School District ("UISD") seeks exemplary teacher candidates to participate in postgraduate studies at Texas A&M International University (TAMIU).

The vision of this initiative is to prepare teachers at the classroom/campus levels who will serve to instruct dual enrollment courses to interested/qualifying UISD students.

The Process

Teacher candidates must submit:

- 1. Completed UISD application.
- 2. **Recommendation form** completed by the Principal or their designee.
- 3. **Resume** addressing the elements below:

Goal: The applicant will state their reason(s) for pursuing a Master's Degree or 18 hours in the content area dual- enrollment certification

- Employment history
- Educational background
- Courses taught
- Leadership experience
- Honors and awards
- Community service
- Consultant service
- Membership in professional organizations

Timeline

May 1-17 - Interested candidates should research TAMIU process for acceptance into a graduate program.

May 18: UISD will provide application documents through Human Resources.

May 24: <u>DEADLINE</u> for application documents to be submitted to the Human Resources Office.

June 1: District will notify applicants of their selection for this program.

June 2: Final admissions deadline for summer session 2017

June 5: First day of summer session 2017 classes

Selection Criteria

Selection Criteria will be based on the following:

- 1. Acceptance into a graduate program at TAMIU.
- 2. Submittal of the UISD application, Reference Form and Resume to Human Resources.
- 3. In case there are more interested candidates than funds available for tuition and fees, candidates will be selected based on the elements listed above, and on a first-come/first-served basis determined by the time stamp on your application to Human Resources.
