

Open Meetings Act Changes Effective September 1, 2025

1. All school board meetings are required to be posted at least three business days prior to the date of the meeting. This will mean that for a Monday board meeting, the agenda must be posted on Tuesday of the prior week. (HB 1522)
2. All school board meetings must be recorded. School districts with fewer than 10,000 students may choose to audio or video record the open session portions of the meetings, while school districts with enrollments of 10,000 or more must video and audio record the open session portions of their meetings. (SB 413)
3. The minutes from school board meetings must now include a record of how each board member voted on each action item. (SB 413)
4. Public comment is to be presented at the beginning of each board meeting. (SB 12)
5. All school board meetings must be held “outside of typical work hours.” (SB 12)
