Student Residency (Letter of Residency)

Students Living with District Residents

Only students who are residents of the District may attend a District school without a tuition charge, except as otherwise provided below or in State law. A student's residence is the same as the person who has legal custody of the student, as defined in Board Policy 7:60.

Due to personal and family circumstances a parent/guardian wishing to enroll a student in the District may not have access to the documents required to establish residency as noted in Exhibit 7:60-E-1. and 7:60-AP-2. In these cases, parents/guardians who reside with a student in a residence within the School District must provide verification of this arrangement. Parents/Guardians seeking to enroll the student living with a District resident must reside with the student at that residence.

Parents/guardians seeking to enroll a student under these circumstances must verify this arrangement in writing. The person with whom the student and parent/guardian are residing must also verify this arrangement. These individuals will be informed of the legal consequences due to falsification of this verification as defined in State Law 5/10-20.12b(c).
