## Directory Information

“Directory information” means those items of ~~is~~ personally identifiable information contained in a student education record ~~from the educational records of students~~ which is not generally considered harmful or an invasion of privacy if released. ~~The following categories are designated as directory information and may be made public by district schools or officials, except as prohibited by the parent.~~

Directory information may be released through appropriate procedures and includes:

1. Student’s name;
2. [Student’s photograph;]
3. [Major field of study;]
- ~~4. —Parents’ names;~~
- ~~5. —Residential address (including electronic address);~~
- ~~6. —Listed telephone numbers;~~
- ~~7. —Date and place of birth;~~
- 8.4. Participation in officially recognized activities and sports ~~and activities;~~
- 9.5. Height and weight ~~or~~ of members of athletic teams ~~members;~~
- 10.6. [Dates of attendance;]
- ~~11. —Illness or accident information as required in health and safety emergencies;~~
- 12.7. Degrees ~~and~~ ~~or~~ awards received;
- ~~13. —Dates of attendance;~~
- ~~14. —Most recent previous school or program attended;~~
- ~~15. —Photograph;~~
16. —Major field of study.

## Public Notice

The district ~~will~~**shall** give annual public notice to parents of students in attendance and students 18 years of age or emancipated. The notice shall identify the types of information considered to be directory information, the district's option to release such information and the requirement that the district must, by law ~~upon request~~, release secondary students' names, addresses and telephone numbers to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher education, unless parents or eligible students request the district withhold this information. Such notice ~~will~~**shall** be given prior to ~~release of~~**releasing** directory information. Directory information may be released to the media and for use in other local publications upon the direction of the principal ~~and in accordance with policy~~. Directory information in the form of lists of students, addresses and phone numbers shall **not** be released to vendors or others desiring to solicit students for contributions or purchase.

## Exclusions

Exclusions from any or all directory categories named as directory information or release of information to military recruiters and/or institutions of higher education must be submitted in writing to the principal by the parent, student 18 years of age or emancipated ~~student within~~**students with** 15 days of annual public notice. A parent or student 18 years of age or an emancipated student, may not opt out of directory information to prevent the district from disclosing or requiring a student to disclose their name, identifier, institutional email address in a class in which the student is enrolled or from requiring a student to disclose a student ID card or badge that exhibits information that has been properly designated directory information by the district in this policy.

Directory~~No directory~~ information shall be released ~~only with~~**without** administrative direction~~authorization~~.

Directory information considered by the district to be~~No detrimental~~ ~~information~~**information** will ~~not~~ be released.

Information will not be given over the telephone except in health and safety emergencies.

At no point will a student's Social Security Number or student identification number be considered directory information. The district shall not, in accordance with state law, disclose personal information for the purpose of enforcement of federal immigration laws.
