AGENDA TOPICS 4-2-14

- Mrs. Miller discussed the upcoming professional development dates.
 - April 29th – Wonders (new reading series training) for all K-2 teachers and Reading Coaches. 8:30-11:30- all Kindergarten Teachers and Reading Coaches; 12:30-3:30 – 1st and 2nd grade teachers.
 - April 30th – Imagine Learning Training: All Reading Coaches, Lab Assistants and Administrators
 - May 1st – Wonders training for 3rd-6th grade teachers. Session 1: 3rd and 4th and Session 2: 5th and 6th
 - Mrs. Miller and Carol Meyer designed a survey that will ascertain staff interest for Summer PD. The calendar will be forthcoming.
- Summer Learning 2014 Plan
 - The summer program SOAR (Summer Opportunities for Academic enrichment and skill Retention) is proposed for June 9th – July 3rd. Sessions will be held at three elementary sites [(Whittier: Angelou & Whittier students) (Holmes: Lowell and Holmes students) (Bryant: Bryant and Sandburg students)] and at the middle school, from Monday through Thursday, 9:00 am-1:00 pm for students and 8:30 am – 1:30 pm for staff. Principals will serve as Site Coordinators and will receive payment for the days that extend past their regular contracted end date of June 30th. Mrs. Miller will meet with Park District officials to discuss a possible partnership with the school district for summer enrichment.
 - The last day of school for all students will be June 4th and it will be a full day.
- Technology Update
 - The delays and issues with technology were discussed. Mrs. Miller shared that Ray Osmolski was in constant contact with AT&T representatives to address the issues that we have been having since our broadband width has been extended and they are working diligently at getting the issues settled.
 - Work orders are being addressed and handled in a more efficient manner, as well.
 - Principals asked about pushing days back for Progress Reports & End of Qtr, due to the extended make-up days. Progress Reports are now due April 17th and will all go out at the same time. The end of the 4th qtr will now be May 30th instead of May 23rd.
- PAARC Update
 - An update was given on the PAARC assessment. Mrs. Miller will keep the administrative staff abreast of any updates as she receives them.
- CDC HIV Prevention Program
 - Our district has been chosen as one of 15 districts that the Centers for Disease Control have chosen to implement an HIV prevention program. All Illinois schools will benefit from the program, but our district will receive more intensive services from ISBE. Dr. Jones presented an overview of the requirements, as she will serve as the liaison for the district.
