December 2025 - Activities Director Board Report

After returning from the Thanksgiving Break, Winter Sports and Activities are officially in full swing for the School District of Tomahawk. Participation numbers seem to be constant compared to previous years, but some sports have less student-athletes and others increased in number. The schedule for the Winter is always fluctuating due to weather and academic related items to maneuver around for all school districts such as holiday concerts, club programming, and the Holidays. As always, pay attention to the school calendar and local communication outlets for any changes that may occur during this busy month.

Tomahawk High School:

Girls Basketball

- Currently 7-2 (3 - 1 GNC)
- The Girls are off to their best start in recent memory for both the season and in conference play.
- They defeated Portage 50-47 to win the Tomahawk Holiday Basketball Tournament over the break held in the Fieldhouse.

Boys Basketball

- Currently 2 - 7 (0 - 3 GNC)
- The boys have been off to a slow start, their competitiveness in games is showing and results are often tied to missed shots and turnovers.
- They were able to pick up an opening round win at the Tomahawk Holiday Basketball Tournament before falling to state ranked Spencer in the finals.

Boys Hockey

- Currently 9 - 2 (4 - 0 GNC)
- Hockey continues to produce great results on the ice to begin the season. They traveled to the very competitive Neenah Red Nosed Rocket Hockey Tournament where they lost to State Ranked #1 SPASH to open the tournament before finishing with a win over D1 Middleton.
- Jonah Dickens has surpassed 2025 graduate, Austin Lamer, and is now the school record holder for Career Points.
- Jett Reilly and Jonah Dickens are both top 5 state wide in points to begin the season.

Boys Swimming

- Currently 1 - 4 (1 - 2 GNC)
- The Boys have started off the season with very tough competition with most of their events being against D1 Schools at Large Meets and nonconference scheduling.
- They will begin to get into the heavy GNC portion of the schedule before starting their taper to get ready for the conference and WIAA Sectional Meet.

Boys Wrestling

- Currently 4 - 1 (2 - 0 GNC)
- Boys Wrestling has experienced the most postponements so far this season due to weather. We have to make up a GNC dual with Antigo in 2026, along with the inability to travel to their scheduled Holiday Tournament at UW-Eau Claire.

- In their early tournaments, Tomahawk has competed in the top 5 of very large tournaments, with multiple students finishing in the top 3.

Girls Wrestling

- Girls Wrestling continues to gain experience and matches as the season progresses.
- Kylie Peissig was the Champion of the Hodag Tournament, defeating the returning Michigan State Champion in her weight class.
- We are a little bottlenecked when it comes to duals this year with a majority of our students competing in two of the designated weight classes and inability to fill some mid weights currently.

Musical

- The students have begun their preparation for the Musical that will take the stage the first week of March.

Forensics

- Forensics practices will be beginning now that we are back from the Holiday Break.
