BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Lake Orion Community Schools requested bids for bond and sinking fund projects as identified in the approved bond list approved on November 6, 2018. Architect, GMB and Construction Manager, Frank Rewold and Sons, wrote the bids according to the standards and specifications of the district. The bids were advertised in the local newspaper, the Sigma website, and the district website. Bids were received on April 16, 2020. The projects, as presented, are tracking in line with the established budgets for the projects.

FUNDING SOURCE & ACCOUNT NUMBER:

The projects will be funded with our Sinking Funds and Series 1 Bond resources.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

It is recommended that the Board of Education authorize the Administration to execute contracts, as presented, in the bid package attached for the renovations at the LOHS Soccer Stadium and the new playground at Webber Elementary in the amount of \$924,242.00. Please note we are decreasing the previously awarded Webber Elementary allowances and contingencies by (\$119,024.00) for a net total recommendation of **\$805,218.00.**

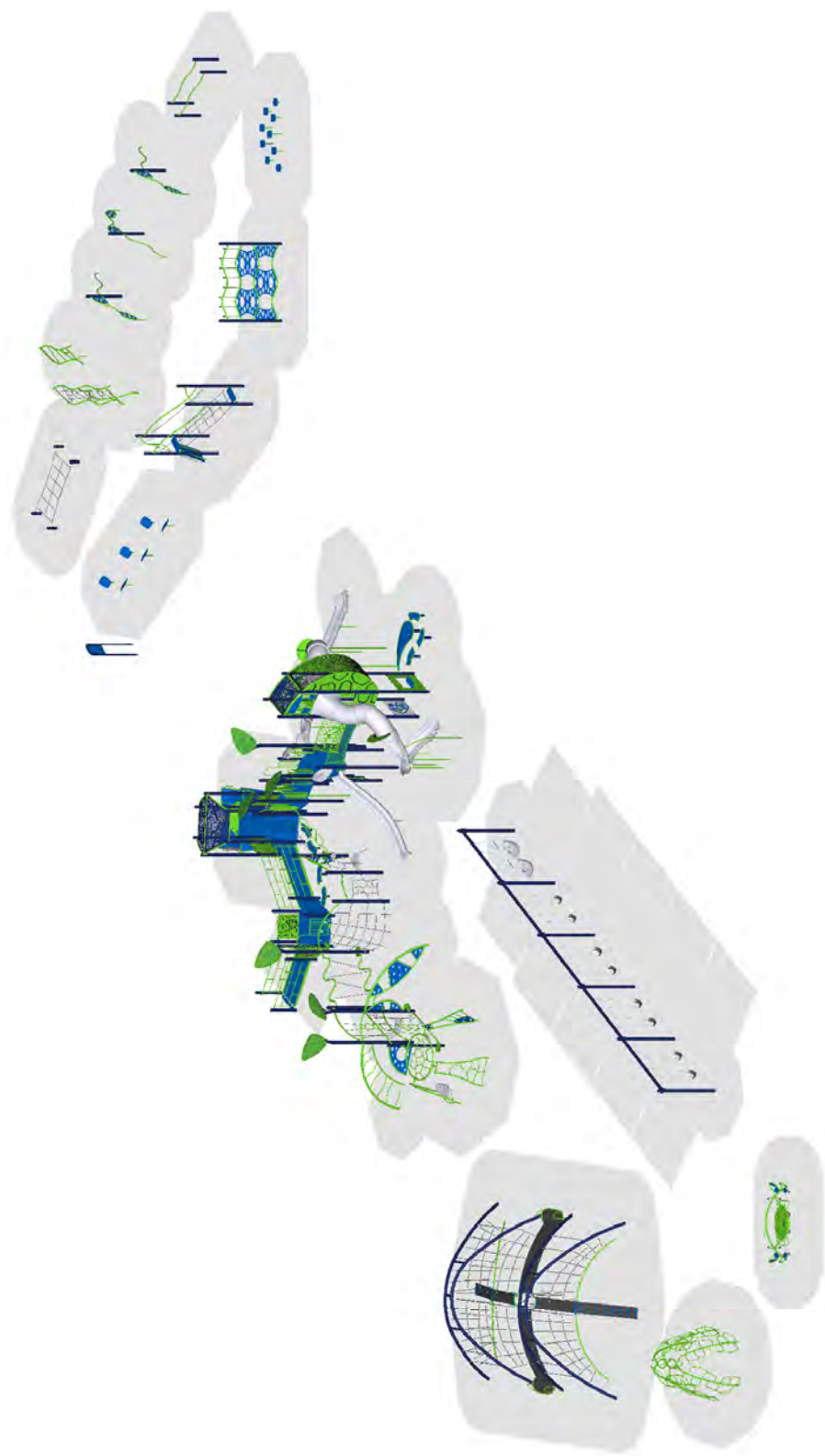
ELEVATION PLAN
