Re: Approval of Summer 2022 Boiler Projects - Sinking Fund

Based upon the District's 10-year facilities and sinking fund plan, I am recommending boiler replacement projects at the following seven (7) buildings: Churchill High School, Churchill High School pool boiler, Stevenson High School, Buchanan Elementary, Livonia Career Technical Center, Cleveland Elementary, Randolph Elementary and Jackson Early Childhood Center. I am requesting this 2022 boiler replacement project be placed on the agenda for the Monday, February 14, 2022, Committee of the Whole meeting.

The bids for these sinking fund projects were opened on February 3, 2022. The low responsible bidder was Engineered Comfort Systems, Inc. in the amount of \$1,951,832.32 with a deduct for the award of all buildings of \$58,954.97 for a final total bid amount of \$1,892,877.35. I am recommending an 8% contingency amount of \$151,430.19 for a total Board approval amount for the 2022 boiler replacement project of \$2,044,307.54.
