Explanation of Policy Changes Update 76

All policies listed below are local unless noted otherwise.

- BBB This policy is revised to update the years in which Board Member places are scheduled for election.
- CAA In this policy the reference to administrative regulations was deleted as unnecessary since the policy is written at a high level of detail.
- CE This policy is updated to include language that characterizes the budgeting process as being "Program Based" as recommended in the Curriculum Audit.
- DC The Explanatory Notes that accompanied Update 76 incorrectly stated that we did not have the most current version of this policy and others in the DC series. We confirmed with TASB that the policies are current. Although the policies are current, we are recommending changes to this policy that clarify posting of vacancies for positions requiring licenses or certificates and opportunities for internal transfers.
- DEA The change recommended for DEA local involves changing the timeframe for the workweek to Sunday at 12:00 a.m. until 11:59 p.m. on Saturday. This provides better opportunity to allow repayment of work time during the week in which the time is accrued.
- This policy is changed to include a reference to Administrative Regulations that now include a description of "Substantial Care" by a grandparent. The policy specifies that this requirement is two hours per school day for five days in a school week. The Administrative Regulation and form are included for your review. The paragraph describing a hearing opportunity before the Board for removal after determination of illegal attendance has been deleted and replaced with a reference to the appropriate complaint policy. Wording that requires the district to bill a parent for days if illegal attendance has been changed to allow, but not require it.
- FDB This policy has been changed to move much of the transfer detail to the Administrative Regulations. The Administrative Regulations are attached for your review.
- FFG This exhibit has been revised to include additional law enforcement agencies and their contact numbers.

- FL This policy has been revised to bring it into compliance with district practice. Parents may elect to have either all or none of their children's Directory Information with held.
- FO The change in this policy involves deleting an obsolete provision for corporal punishment. The district has not allowed corporal punishment for many years.
- FO Legal This legal policy is an alternate provided by TASB to match with the recommended FO local and excludes corporal punishment as a disciplinary consequence.
