**TOPIC: RESOLUTION TO APPROVE LINWOOD COMMUNITY PARK  
AND SCHOOL FOREST AMENDED AGREEMENT**

**BACKGROUND:** At the January 16, 1996 School Board meeting, the board approved the Linwood Community Park and School Forest Agreement. The Linwood Community Park and School Forest collaboration project is between Linwood Township and the School District.

The Linwood Community Park and School Forest now consists of 210 acres and is the largest park within Linwood. The park offers many opportunities to enjoy the outdoors. The current facilities include: guided nature trails, boardwalks, picnic tables and benches, plus cross country skiing and sliding in the winter months. A public parking lot is located on the north side of the park on 227<sup>th</sup> avenue about a ½ mile west of Typo Creek Drive. Cty Rd. 85.

**PROCESS:** The Town of Linwood recently acquired 40 additional acres to add to the Linwood Community Park and School Forest collaboration project. A copy of the amended agreement and a map of the site are attached.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Administration requests adoption of the Linwood Community Park and School Forest Amended Agreement.

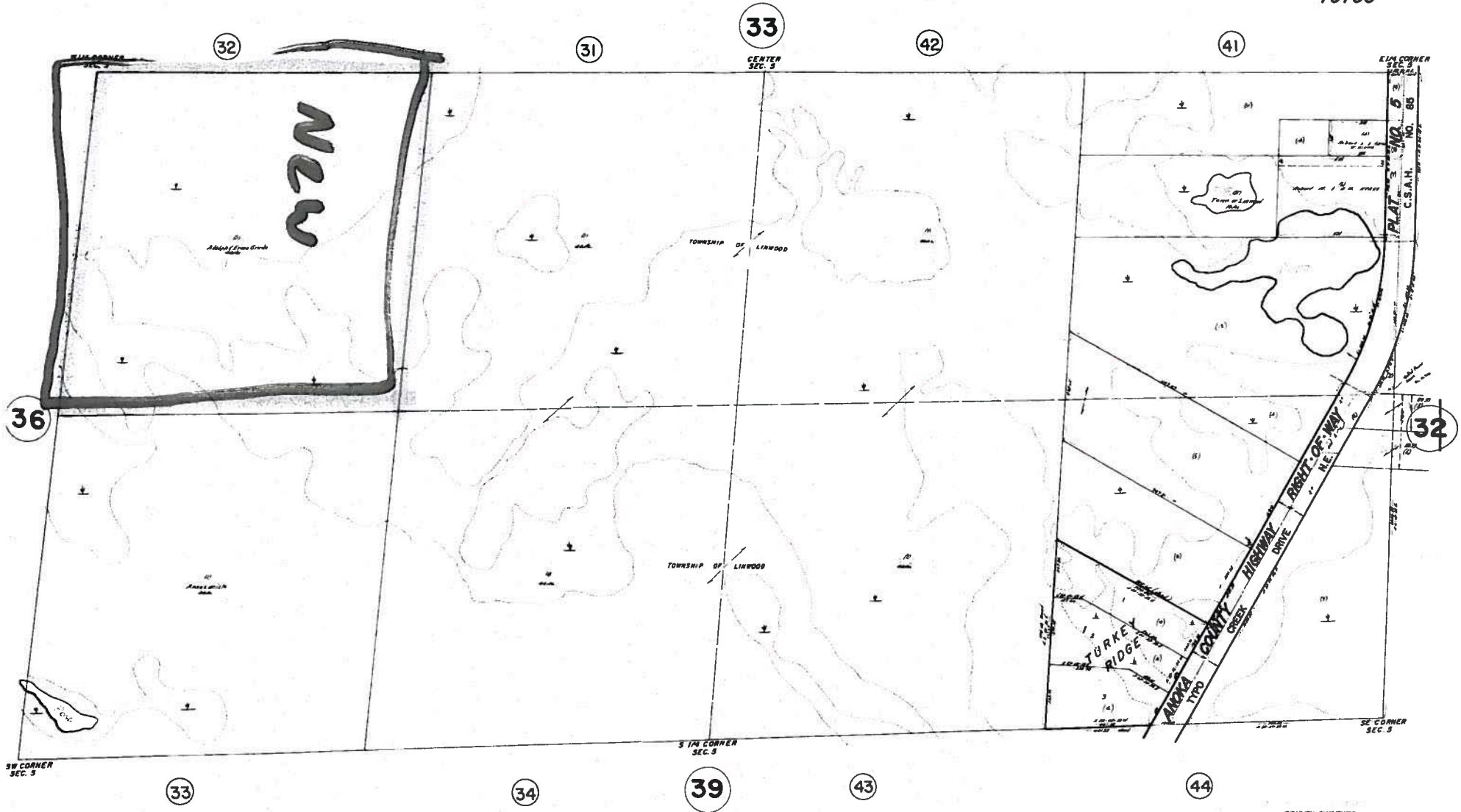

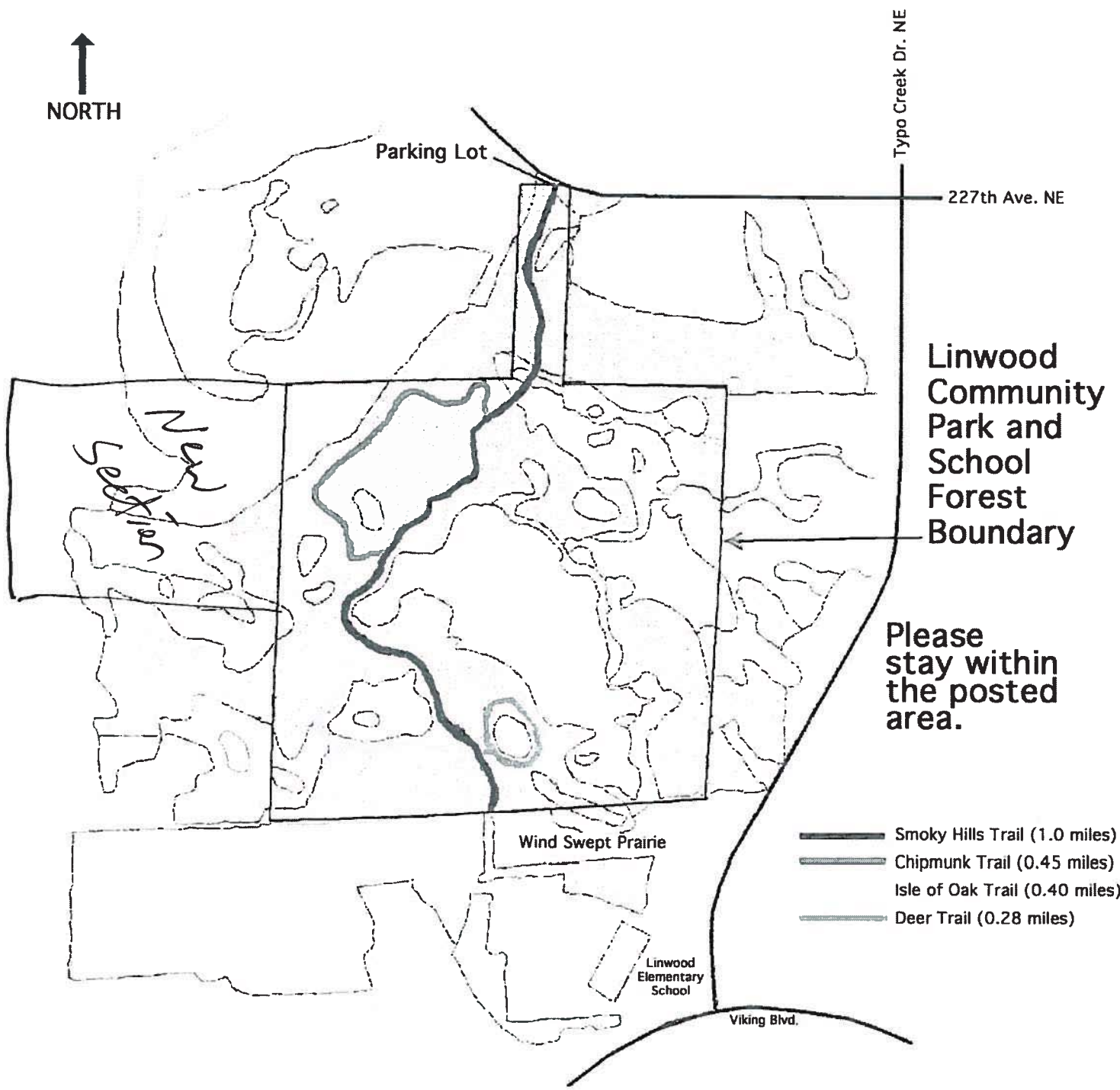
