Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Board of Directors

Held in the Belmond-Klemme High School Library 411 Tenth Avenue Northeast, Belmond, Iowa 50421

Thursday, April 22, 2021 - TENTATIVE - UNAPPROVED

The Board of Directors for the Belmond-Klemme Community School District met for a special board meeting at the above date at 7:00 P.M.

On Friday, March 20, 2020, Governor Reynolds signed a proclamation easing the rules for public meetings during the course of the COVID-19 public health emergency. The requirement that school boards have a physical meeting location where the public can congregate to listen to the meeting was temporarily suspended. During this time period, meetings must be hosted entirely through electronic means.

The meeting was called to order by Board President Rick McDaniel.

President McDaniel asked for the roll to be called. The Board Secretary called the roll. Present for the meeting were Rick McDaniel, Michelle Murphy, Sharon Barkema, Gary Berkland, Ryan Meyer, and Jim Swenson. Marc Schlichting was absent. Also present were Superintendent Dan Frazier, and Board Secretary Thelma Martinez. President McDaniel determined that a quorum was present.

President McDaniel called for a public hearing on the proposed High School Addition and Renovation Project. There were no public comments. President McDaniel closed the hearing.

President McDaniel asked to approve the agenda. Moved by Barkema; seconded by Murphy. Motion carried 6/0.

Secondary School Building Repairs, Improvements, and Renovations, Phase III: Acceptance of Bids for the High school renovation Project

Architect Wineinger presented the bids to the board. Superintendent Frazier recommended the board move to accept the low bid of Henkel Construction of Mason City for a total cost for all bids of \$2,083,548.00. Moved by Swenson; seconded by Berkland. Motion carried 6/0.

Resolution Directing the Sale of Approximately \$1,800,000 School Infrastructure Sales, Services, and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2021

Matthew Gillaspie from Piper Sandler & Co. presented to the board the bids for the bond sale. Board Member Swenson introduced the following Resolutin entitled "RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SALE OF APPROXIMATELY \$1,8000,000 SCHOOL

INFRASTRUCTURE SALES, SERVICES AND USE TAX REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2021" and moved its adoption. Board Member Barkema seconded the motion to adopt. The roll was called and the vote was:

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE SALE OF \$1,830,000 SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE SALES, SERVICES AND USE TAX REVENUE BONDS, SERIES 2021

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE BELMOND-KLEMME COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT:

Section 1. The School district has received a proposal for the sale of the Bonds and has arranged for the sale of these Bonds to First State Bank and Green Belt Bank & Trust, at a purchase price of \$1,830,000 plus accrued interest to date of delivery; and

Section 2. That the form of contract for the sale of the bonds is approved and the President and Secretary are authorized and directed to execute the contract for sale of the Bonds on behalf of the School District.

Section 3. That the President and Secretary are authorized and directed to issue and deliver \$1,830,000 School Infrastructure Sales, Services and Use Tax Revenue Bonds, Series 2021, in the aggregate principal amount of \$1,830,000, in the denomination of \$100,000 or integral multiples of \$1,000 in excess thereof, bearing interest and maturing as follows:

Section 4. That all acts of the Superintendent of Schools, Secretary of the Board, and Placement Agent done in furtherance of the sale of the Bonds are ratified and approved.
