4.A Reports & Presentations - Superintendent

- **1. Test Scores:** Mr. Burrows presented test score graphs following 2 of the 3 tests that have been taken. Only one school (IHS) has taken all 3 tests at this time. He reported that at AC Houghton, all 3rd graders have passed the reading tests.
- **2. MCSD Job Fair:** Reported that the 1st Annual Morrow County School District Job Fair was successful with everyone doing a great job of selling Morrow County and the School District. Several teachers were offered contracts as a result of the fair. Nancy Vander Does brought cake and berries to celebrate the event.
- **3. Math Contest:** Reported that Riverside High School hosted the event this year, with 127 kids participating in grades 4-8. Everyone did a great job.
- **4. Crystal Apple Awards:** The event to honor Crystal Apple Award winners will be held on May 10th at the Red Lion in Pendleton. District recipients are Deb Sherman and Kathleen Spinks (teachers) and Carmen Diaz and Karen Lunders (classified). These ladies were selected by a nomination of their peers.
- **5. School Funding:** Mr. Burrows reported that the latest news in school funding shows that Morrow County School District should get an additional \$180,000 next year.
- **6. Teacher Appreciation Week:** Superintendent Burrows read a proclamation in honor of Teacher Appreciation Week (May 8th through the 12th). Cakes will be delivered to each school on Wednesday for all staff in recognition of the great job that teachers do for our students.
