School Health Advisory Council Meeting  
Thursday, April 2, 2015  
Minutes

The fourth SHAC meeting for the 2014-15 school year was held Thursday, April 2, 2015 from 12:00 pm to 1:00 pm. Those in attendance were Reva Salazar MJHS student, Denise Fenner BISD RN, Adriana McKinnon of Women's Shelter of South Texas, Gracy Bryce TJIS PE Teacher, and Cindy Clendennen Co-chair.

Items on the agenda included:

**Evaluation of the BISD Local School Wellness Policy: SCAN Survey Results**

The SHAC reviewed progress made on the Local School Wellness Plan, in particular the School and Community Actions Survey for Nutrition (SCAN) Survey. This survey has 6 components: Wellness Policy, School Environment, Student Education Programs, Professional Development Programs, Parent Involvement, and Community Partnerships. All areas are evaluated by each campus with a compilation of data for BISD results. Results and a comparison between 2013-14 and 2014-15 include:

Major causes of an increased score are related to categories in Wellness Policy and Professional Development Programs. Two students are on the SHAC while none were last year. Secondly, in the area of Professional Development, a nutrition education specialist has been available for consultation regarding nutrition-related programs. The Region II, ESC has provided an individual this year. In the past, there was none.

This information will be reported to the School Board at the May meeting as well as informing the public. Results will be posted on the district web site.
