Issue Summary:

The School Climate Connectedness Survey is an online survey involving two student surveys (grades 3-5 and 6-12), one staff survey, and one family survey.

The s survey window was open from January 17 - March 25, 2022.

Fliers promoting the School Climate Connectedness Survey, along with parent notification, were sent to site administrators. In addition, information encouraging parent participation was added to the District website and Facebook page and sent to parents via School Messenger. A public service announcement was played on KBRW, and QR codes were created for Ipalook, Hopson, and Barrow High School and placed at a booth at Stuqpuk.

Ms. Laura Havens, with AASB, will present the School Climate Connectedness Survey results. The documents behind this memo accompany the presentation.

Background:

The School Climate and Connectedness Survey is a voluntary statewide survey that measures positive school climate, how connected students feel to adults and peers, social and emotional learning (SEL), and observed risk behaviors at school or school events. The American Institute for Research, in partnership with the Association of Alaska School Board, developed the School Climate Connectedness Survey.

The North Slope Borough School District has participated in the School Climate Connectedness Survey in 2008, 2010, and every year since 2017. The data collected is used for school improvement and grant purposes.
