The Salquist property is the last property in this end of the city for a future school or school use. To my knowledge there hasn't been a study to validate surplusing the property, and growth in this end of Gresham continues. My sales partner and I sold all the lots in Spence Acres and many of the homes when built. I live on one of the lots. Look around and you'll see single family homes and development already built and being built on Chase Road, 282nd with lots of kids coming into the pipeline in the future. A two story building can be built for the future education as the times would dictate. It's short-sighted to surplus this property.

Kelly Creek Grade School is on a small parcel of property. Don't lose sight of future needs. When is the last time a study has even been made of future needs and use? Looks like approximately 700+ kids would be added into the school system within the next year with the current homes built and 272 condos on Chase Road, and the 4plex condos at corner of 282nd and SE Powell Valley Road.
