Important School Information

Cell Phones:

- Classroom time is essential to ensure our students graduate with the set of skills they need to be successful in life outside of school. Cell phones can be quite distracting for our high school students and the research suggests students are better able to focus when this distraction is not present.
- Teachers will be collecting cell phones at the classroom entrance again this year. If a student refuses to give their phone to the teacher, they will be sent to the main office to speak with administration and the phone will be held until a parent or guardian can come and pick it up. If a student refuses to give a cell phone to administration, it will be an automatic out-of-school suspension.

Personal Computers/Devices:

- All students will be issued a Chromebook this year. NKN HS uses a program called Go Guardian to monitor student use. Due to this, students will not be permitted to bring personal computers and devices from home. All students will be using a school-issued Chromebook when needed.

Subject: The Importance of Regular School Attendance

Dear Parents/Guardians,

As the school year begins, we wanted to emphasize the critical role that regular school attendance plays in your child's academic success. Consistent attendance allows students to:

- **Build a strong foundation:** Missing classes can disrupt the continuity of learning, making it difficult to grasp new concepts.
- **Develop important skills:** School provides opportunities to learn essential skills like teamwork, communication, and problem-solving.
- **Form positive relationships:** Regular attendance fosters connections with teachers and peers, which can enhance the learning experience.

To help keep track of the number of days your student has accumulated, we have provided a magnetic attendance tracker. These can be used to mark the number of days your student has missed and alert you when they have missed 10 days of school.

We understand that there may be times when absences are unavoidable. However, excessive absences can significantly impact your child's progress. If your child is experiencing difficulties that are affecting their attendance, please don't hesitate to reach out to your child's counselor, teacher, or school administrator. We are here to support you and your child in any way we can.


